

**November Guild Weave
Pine Needle Fall or Christmas Ornaments
Saturday, November 9th, 2024
9AM-4PM at Camp Hill Giant**

Jen Nailor will be teaching our November class on her pine needle/black walnut Christmas ornaments. We will start with a black walnut slice, and coil pine needles to create the ornament. Supplies will be available to make miniature pine branches with wool to decorate the ornament. Jen will make some snowmen to include out of air-dried clay, or participants can bring small Christmas buttons or embellishments for their ornaments. The picture is Jen's Fall ornaments, but the same can be done for Christmas ornaments. There should be plenty of time to make two ornaments.



Kits include two black walnut slices, Irish waxed linen thread, 1 oz treated pine needles, and small embellishment. If interested in the Fall pumpkins, please note that on the class form. Additional kits can be purchased if interested.

Participants should bring small sharp scissors, nippers, and a 1-inch piece of drinking straw if you prefer a gauge for coiling. (Jen does not use a gauge in coiling, but some coilers prefer a gauge.)
