WEAVER'S DELIGHT TRAVELING BASKET (By Beth Sager) Instructor: Anne Kelly

This "all day" weave features 3 baskets in one! This basket is easy enough for a beginner but provides a shaping challenge to the experienced weaver. It is a wonderful container for the basketmaker, quilter or other crafter on the move. Please contact Anne Kelly before April 15 to order a pattern [\$3.50] and if you also want to order the D handle, dowels and round ball knobs [\$8].

Materials:

Large Basket

12" wide x19" high D handle

3/4" flat reed (cut 10 spokes @ 40" and 10 spokes @ 35")

 $\frac{1}{2}$ " flat reed (cut 9 base fillers @ 21")

4-3/16" dowels @ 7" (support construction for Large Basket)

8-1" round ball knobs (support construction for Large Basket)

Tool Basket

3/4" flat reed (cut 9 spokes @ 26" and 11 spokes @ 22") 3/8" flat reed (cut 8 base fillers @ 19")

Clothespin Basket

3/4" flat reed (cut 3 spokes @ 19" and 7 spokes @ 14") 3/8" flat reed (cut 6 base fillers @ 7")

All baskets use the following materials:

#3 round reed (base twiner)

1/2" flat reed (weavers)

1/4" flat oval reed – dyed (weavers)

3/8" flat reed (rim row)

1/2" flat oval reed (rim)

#4 seagrass (rim filler)

3/16" flat oval reed (lasher)

Dianne and Jean will be demonstrating how to make snowflakes and reindeer. Bring 1/4 inch reed (or any narrow size) to make smaller ornaments; 1/2 inch reed for a larger reindeer. You will also need Tacky Glue for the snowflakes - Dianne recommends the kind that comes in small pots as it is thicker than the bottled Tacky glue. Try to bring your best reed, as the wrong side shows at some bends especially on the reindeer ornament.
