Class Fee: \$42 4 Hours 16 "L All Levels

Learn to fringe and twirl wool strips to create the realistic wool pinecones and branches for this great holiday decoration. Beautiful colors will be available. All supplies and tools are provided by the teacher. All skill levels are encouraged.

## NANTUCKET BRACELET Denise Bendelewski



Class Fee \$47 All Levels 2 Hours (6-8pm)

Students will use a 3/4" inch metal bracelet to make a Nantucket bracelet adding acrylic caps to finish the bracelet. Students can choose black or white caps and black or natural cane weavers.

## A LITTLE BIT OF COLOR NANTUCKET Candy Barnes



Class Fee: \$70 5 1/2" dia. X 3 ½"H 4 Hours Beginner

Students will insert tapered staves in a cherry base and will weave with cane over a class mold. A turned rim will be glued on. Students will have an option to be creative with the color accent. Materials will be provided. Tools will be supplied by the teacher for class use.

Some weavers may not complete basket in allotted time, but instructor will work with you to finish by the end of the Odyssey convention.

## NANTUCKET COFFEE SCOOP OR BOTTLE OPENER Denise Bendelewski



Class Fee \$20 3/4" x 5" (scoop) 3/4" x 7"(opener) 2 Hours(8-10pm) All Levels

Student will weave using cane on a wooden dowel to make either a coffee scoop or a bottle opener.

#### TRISTAN'S TRINKET BASKET Jan Beyma



Class Fee \$70 2 1/2"H x 5"dia.

4 Hours Beginner

Intermediate

Students will learn the basics of setting up and weaving a Nantucket basket. Stakes and weavers are cane. Basket is woven over a plastic mold for class use. The base, rim and lid will be cherry and will be pre-finished. Tools will be provided for class use.

#### PINE NEEDLE PENDANT Vickie Echols



Class Fee: \$35 2 Hours (8-10pm) 2"x2" (experience with pine needles is helpful)

We will learn how to coil glycerinated pine needles onto a prepared cabochon to create a unique pendant. We will learn different ways of adding glass or metal beads, how to make closed coil bales and how to picot the edge. Choice of natural or dyed pine needles. Tools Needed: needle nose pliers, good sharp scissors, fine-tip wire cutter.

#### ALTERED TURTLE BASKET Vickie Echols



Class Fee \$35 8" x 5" x 2"H

2 Hours (6-8pm) All Levels

Use up your gourd scraps to create this altered turtle basket. We will start with a prepared gourd shard that resembles a turtle shell. We will learn how to coil glycerinated pine needles onto the shard while incorporating beads to create our unique turtle baskets. Tools Needed: sharp scissors, small needle nose pliers, fine-tipped wire cutters.

### PAPER JAPANESE LEAF Annetta Kraayeveld



Class Fee: \$48 6 1/2" x 4 1/2" x 2"

4 Hours Intermediate/advanced

Using hand painted paper strips, we will weave a beautiful leaf scoop. The leaf scoop is a traditional Japanese woven form. Teacher will provide a wide choice of paper (painted and pre-cut). Tools Needed: students should bring sharp scissors, several toothless micro clips, small bent packer and a number 26 tapestry needle.

#### TWILL "PAPER" WEIGHT Annetta Kraayeveld



Class Fee: \$56 4 1/4" x 2 3/4" x 1"

3 Hours (7-10pm) Intermediate/advanced

Students will weave a twill pattern with colorful hand painted paper cut into 1/8" strips. Your beautiful woven piece is then encased in a quality solid glass paperweight. The pattern includes graphs for several designs. A wide choice of paper colors (painted and pre-cut) will be available. **Students must be able to read a graph and have twill experience.** Tools Needed: bring a small packer, several toothless micro-clips, and a pair of sharp side cutters.

## MADRAS PLANTER Kathy Petronzio



Class Fee: \$62 11" x 4" x 5" 4 Hours Adv. Beginner/Intermediate

This sweet basket will be taught using basic basketry skills including shaping. Students will create an arrow design using waxed linen. Three pottery cups are included for plants or herbs. This basket is woven with space dyed reed to create the madras color. Some students may not finish in four hours but will know what to do to finish.

### SHADOW BOX Mary Price



Class Fee: \$49 12" sq. X 2 ½" H (4 ½ "w/handle) 4 Hours Adv. Beginner

Students will learn a triple boxed woven base using natural and dyed reed. The sides and rims are woven using traditional methods. Black leather handles are added when rimming the basket. Bring the usual basketry tools.

### NOT YOUR GRANDMA'S MASHER Mary E. Skillings



Class Fee: \$25 Size varies 4 Hours All Levels

I will provide old and recycled mashers. Students will choose a masher and style to weave. Round mashers are limited. Basic plaited construction. Multiple colors of dyed reed available. We will also discuss about recycling discarded utensils; my sampler of items repurposed will be shared.

### TOM THUMB'S LAUNDRY BASKET Joyce B Smith



Class Fee: \$55 2 1/2"L x 3"W x 1"H 4 Hours All Levels

A miniature ash basket woven over a class mold. This basket is a must for anyone who collects miniatures.

## Thursday Evening (6 pm-10pm) and Saturday (8am-12pm)

## SHAKER CADDIE Dave Barnes



Class Fee \$75 9"W x 12 3/4" L x 2 1/2" H w/ handle Thursday (6-10pm) and Saturday (8-noon) Beginner

Students will build a Shaker Caddie, learning steaming and bending techniques along with using the following power tools: drill press, bandsaw, power sander, steam box, and hammer (provided by the instructor.) Please bring: a pencil and a sharp non-folding utility knife with a new blade. Due to the need for time to air dry the boxes, classes will be held Thursday evening and Saturday. (NOTE: we will be working outside with the power tools.)

## Friday Classes: September 23, 2022

## NANTUCKET WINE COOLER Candy Barnes



Class Fee: \$95 4 1/2" W x 9 ½"H

8 Hours Adv. Beginner

Student will insert tapered staves into a base and weave over a double wall stainless wine cooler, turned rim will be glued on. Students will have options to be creative with color accent materials that will be provided. Tools will be supplied by the teacher.

#### SPACE DYED SURPRISE Denise Bendelewski



Class Fee: \$80 5 1/2"H x 2 1/2"dia.

6 Hours All Levels

Student will make a Nantucket basket using a class mold, weaving with solid dyed cane staves and space dyed weavers. Student will learn how to work with dyed cane. Basket will have a cherry base, slip on rim, and handle with bone knobs.

#### NANTUCKET ELLIPTICAL BASKET Jan Beyma



Class Fee: \$90 7"H x 8" dia.

8 Hours Intermediate

This basket has an unusual shape. Using cane staves and weavers, students will insert weavers into a cherry base and weave the traditional over / under, learning how to build up the back side which is higher than the rest of the basket. The basket is woven over an acrylic class mold. Base and rim are cherry and will be pre-finished.

## RAFFIA BASKET WITH DYED PINE NEEDLES Vickie Echols



Class Fee: \$60 4" x 4" by 4"

6 Hours Intermediate

You will start with a black walnut slice and learn how to work with "hat raffia" to create a variety of stitches that really pop against the glycerinated dyed and natural pine needles. You will learn closed coiling to camouflage your color changes. Students will not finish the project in class but are provided with a detailed tutorial so they will be able to finish at home. Tools Needed: needle nose pliers, good sharp scissors, fine tip wire cutters.

## Friday Classes: September 23, 2022

#### DIAGONAL TWILL BASICS Annetta Kraayeveld



Class Fee: \$85 Approx. 4 1/2" x 41/2" " x 3"H 8 Hours Intermediate

This tutorial explores diagonal twill weaving. Working with the ½" inch strips of hand-painted paper, students will learn the basics of base construction, turning corners, weaving the sides, and counting rows as well as two rimming options. Students will work on two baskets simultaneously. Tools Needed: sharp scissors, toothless micro-clips, a #24 tapestry needle, and a small narrow bent packer. Teacher will have several choices of hand-painted paper kits. Micro clips and 3mm packers will be available for purchase in class.

## EGGPLANT TOWER Kathy Petronzio



Class Fee: \$75 12"H x 4"dia. 8 Hours Adv. Beginner

This tower is over a plastic form with a 4 inch ash base, with 11/64 flat oval reed using a chase weave method. Keeping all the spokes and weaving spaced correctly will be addressed all the way up this tower. An arrow design is added at the top third of this basket.

### SEA GLASS Mary Price



Class Fee: \$50 13" x 5" x 4"H 6 Hours Adv. Beginner

This basket starts with inserting flat reed spokes into an oblong wood base. Techniques include traditional weaving methods, triple twining, cross-stitch weave and is finished with a single lashed rim.

### TEN KNOTS Mary E. Skillings



Class Fee: \$40 7" x 8" x 27" Circumference 8 Hours Intermediate

This basket is a gentle cats-head and double walled basket. Students will weave a cats-head basket using dyed stakes and weavers. Cats-head shaping and chase weaving will complete the inner walls. Natural stakes will be attached to the base. The outer wall is woven in a continuous weave 3/4 of the way up. Twining will then separate the upper portion with dyed start/ stop weaving. Ten knots of Hamburg cane complete the basket. Twill experience is helpful.

## Friday Classes: September 23, 2022

#### FINLEY'S DOUBLE WALL Joyce B. Smith



Class Fee: \$90 3 inch diameter, 2 ¼"H 8 Hours Intermediate

This small double walled black ash basket is woven with ash splint over a class mold.

#### RUSH FOOTSTOOL Angie Wagner



Class Fee: \$75 13 ½" x 12" x 12" H ,1 1/8" square legs 4-6 Hours All Levels

Learn to weave a fiber (paper) rush seat on a handmade footstool. Students will learn the fundamentals of rush and will have knowledge and skills to weave a chair seat. IMPORTANT: This stool is <u>woven while standing</u>. Decent hand strength is needed as well. With the easy pattern, we will concentrate on the technique to get it to look good. Instructor provides: ready to weave stained/sealed footstool, Kraft brown fiber rush, rush tacks, 1" rubber tipped clamp & written instruction booklet. (If the student prefers to stain/paint the stool frame themselves, the frame can be shipped a month prior to Odyssey. ## SUMMER TOTE Kathy Petronzio



Class Fee: \$85 12"L x 6"W x 18"H w/handle 12 Hours Intermediate

This classy tote is woven using reed and dyed Hamburg cane. You begin with an ash base and weave a double wall design. Colorful wooden beads are attached at the center. A leather strap is woven in with the rim. Color choice is dark blue or rust.

### **Saturday Classes: September 24, 2022**

## NANTUCKET CHERRY TRAY Candy Barnes



Class Fee: \$95 9 3/4" x 2 1/2" 8 Hours Adv. Beginner

Students will insert tapered staves into a cherry base and weave over a class mold. The turned cherry rim will be glued on along with flowered center motif button. Students will have an option to be creative with color accent materials that will be provided. Tools will be supplied by the teacher for classroom use.

#### NANTUCKET DITTY BAG Jan Beyma



Class Fee: \$115 7 ½" x 7" 8 Hours Intermediate

The Nantucket ditty bag is woven using cane staves and weavers over a class mold. A combination of traditional and twill weave creates a unique look. Mahogany base and rim are pre-finished. Bone knobs, leather handle, and choice of liner completes the basket.


#### 6 INCH POLYGON Denise Bendelewski



Class Fee: \$90 6" x 3 ½"H 6 Hours All Levels

Students will weave on a class mold. Using cane staves and cane weavers, students will continuous weave on a six sided basket with cherry base and slip on rim. Students will learn to taper staves to fit the six sided mold.

## ANTLER HANDLE WITH FOOT Vickie Echols



Class Fee: \$80 Varies 7" x 9" x 6"or larger 8 Hours Intermediate

Learn how to stitch glycerinated pine needles using artificial sinew onto a prepared gourd to create a foot that will be stabilize the gourd once the antler handle is attached. The antler attaches to the rim of the gourd and is held in place by pine needle coiling. Some floating coils, beads, and twists may be incorporated. A detailed tutorial that will be emailed after class. Tools Needed: needle nose pliers, good sharp scissors, small wire cutters.

### Saturday Classes: September 24, 2022

#### WANDERER Annetta Kraayeveld



Class Fee: \$80 3 1/2" dia. x 7"

8 Hours Intermediate

This attractive canister features a wooden base, an interesting twill arrow, Ti- twining and double Ti- twining. Class baskets will be woven on a mold to assist in shaping and save time. Students will have color options. Tools: bring a small packer and two # 20 tapestry needles along with your regular weaving tools.

## NAUTICAL EDGE Mary Price



Class Fee: \$60 10"dia. x 4 ½"H. 8 Hours Adv. Beginner

This basket is woven using natural and dyed reed. The basket starts with inserting flat reed spokes into a round slotted base. Techniques include double triple-twine, creating double wave embellishments, and a single lashed rim with cotton cord rim filler and handles.

#### HARLEQUIN TOTE Annetta Kraayeveld



Class Fee: \$100 14" x 8 ½" x 10"H 6 Hours All Levels

An attractive tote made to hold up to daily use. The basket features two sizes of colorful stakes, start/stop rows, continuous seagrass rows and a lashed rim, finished off with red leather handles to accent the stakes. Class will focus on maintaining tension and shaping with uneven stakes. Tools: spoke weight, usual weaving tools.

### THE ORIGINAL GINGHAM BASKET Mary E. Skillings



Class Fee: \$35 10" x 10" x 10–11"H 6 Hours All Levels

This basket has basic weaving techniques and includes filling a base with crosshatching. You will make a corner to corner **round reed top handle**. Paired and single stakes are separated in the upper half of the basket. Colors will be autumn shades.

## Saturday Classes: September 24, 2022



Class Fee: \$75 4" dia. x 3 ½"H w/out handle 6 Hours Intermediate

A storage basket woven with Ash splint. The hexagonal weave is usually called the shaker cheese basket weave. The hexagons are formed by interweaving pairs of parallel lines.

## **TOOLS TO BRING!**

Most basket weavers have these tools in their kits...

- sharp basket scissors
- angle or side cutters
- packing tool (flat tip, bent or straight)
- awl
- spoke weight
- needle nose pliers
- knife, shaver or scorp
- measuring tape
- clothes pins or clips

- pencil

#### FAIRY BOWL Denise Bendelewski



Class Fee: \$68 2" x 3" 4 Hours All Levels

Student will weave on a class mold. Using cane staves and cane weavers, the students will weave with continuous weave a round basket with cherry base, slip on rim, and lid with wooden knob.

## A PENNY FOR YOUR THOUGHTS Jan Beyma



Class Fee: \$70 3"H x 6"dia.

4 Hours Beginner

Students will learn to set up and weave a Nantucket basket using cane stakes and weavers. Basic over/under pattern will be woven. Basket will be finished off with a slip on rim. Base and rim will be pre-finished mahogany. The base will have a cut out to insert a shiny new penny or a penny with your birth year. This is a good basket to throw your loose change in. Basket will be woven over a plastic mold for class use. Tools will be provided for class use.

#### TYVEK BEADS AND FLOWERS Vickie Echols



Class Fee: \$35 Flower 2" to 4" Beads 1 1/2" to 3" 2 Hours (8am-10am) All Levels

We will learn some cool effects created by coloring and heating Tyvek. There will be lots of goodies that may be incorporated into your beads and flowers. Teacher provides class materials: Tyvek, inks, bamboo skewer, foils, tips, breads, cellophane, and a detailed Tutorial emailed after class.

#### JUST FOR FUN Annetta Kraayeveld



Class Fee: \$40 3 Hou 5" x 4 1/2" x 5" w/out handle

3 Hours (9am-12pm) adle All Levels

A delightful little gift bag – made with natural reed and dyed overlays. A loop handle made with seagrass completes the basket. Great basket for all weaving levels.

## **Sunday Classes: September 25, 2022**

### BARGELLO MARKET BASKET Annetta Kraayeveld



Class Fee: \$60 9" x 6" x 4"H (8"H w/handle)

4 Hours Intermediate

A little market basket full of fun techniques. Start with a filled base, then add colorful overlays to the stakes and top with a two color bargello pattern. Practice 4 rod wale, reverse 4 rod wale, and step-ups.

### COFFEE CUP Mary Price



Class Fee: \$30 5" diameter by 3 1/2"H 2 Hours (8am-10am) **Beginner** 

This basket is woven using natural and dyed reed. The basket starts with inserting flat spokes into a round, slotted wood base. Techniques include traditional weaving methods, triple twine and incorporating a leather handle into the rows of weaving. The basket is finished with a single lashed rim.

### FATHER CHRISTMAS AND GIFT CARD ORNAMENTS Mary E. Skillings





Class Fee: \$35 Father Christmas, 4" Gift card 2" x 2"

2 Hours (8am-10am) All Levels

Students will get kits for both ornaments and will complete one in a two hour class. Father Christmas is built off a drilled, 1 inch painted wooden ball. Round reed stakes, continuous over/under weaving with dyed reed. Hair, arms, embellishments added. The Gift card is basic construction using small sizes of reed. It will fit a credit card sized gift card. Embellishments are included.

### MATCH BASKET Joyce B. Smith



Class Fee: \$55 3 1/2"L x 1 1/2" W x 2 1/4"H (back is 4 ½"H)

4 Hours All Levels

The Match Basket is a miniature version of the Cherokee Comb basket. It is woven with black ash with or without a class mold.
