Guild member Mary Morgan will be teaching this versatile basket. The Ashlar features a 6 x 12-inch racetrack base custom crafted of cherry and maple hardwoods in a brickwork pattern (ashlar). The sides are woven using a variety of techniques including 3 and 5 rod wale, a basic basket weave, and a twill. Dyed reed is used to highlight the change in weaving patterns. Bring your usual tools.

Cassandra – All Levels – 4-5 hrs. – finished size 9” L x 5” W x 7” H w/o handle - \$55

This is a great basket for a doorknob or to hang by the outside door. The basket starts with a solid woven base so items will not fall out. We will then chase weave using 3/8” FF and 1/4” spaced dyed FF reed. The front will pooch out to make a handy opening. There are space dyed overlays on every other spoke. The handle is turquoise dyed leather.

Bring usual basket tools including a **spoke weight**, packers, clips, scarfer, cutting board, scissors.



Electric Blues – High Intermediate and up – 8 hrs. – Finished size 11” long x 9” wide x 8” high - \$80

This beautiful tote has accents of purple, blue and teal spaced dyed reed in flat oval and round reed and is finished with sassy teal leather handles. The twill is a 3/2, the cathead and shape are a big emphasis. Slower weavers may need to rim after class. Usual basket tools including needle a **spoke weight**, nose pliers, scissors, angle cutters, spray bottle, towel, clips, packers, tape measure, scraper & cutting board, and any other tools you find useful.



Both classes will begin at 9 am. Please be a few minutes early to set-up your work area. You may bring your lunch or purchase it downstairs. If you bring coffee/tea or other drinks, BE SURE IT IS IN A LEAK & SPILL PROOF CONTAINER.

Register early as some supplies may be limited, due to the current uncertainty of getting supplies from China. Right now (May 2025) my wholesaler is not ordering any more supplies until he sees what is happening. While I believe I have enough materials on-hand for this class, I could open several packages of reed only to

discover that they are substandard and I might not be able to get more. Should the occasion arise that I am not able to provide you a kit, I will notify you ASAP and return your check. Please be understanding that this is beyond my control.

If you sign up, but cannot attend, your kit will either go home with a friend of yours or be given to you at another event. Please let me know if you cannot attend at the last minute, so we can figure it out. Thank you for your cooperation.
