OMAHA SWING DANCE CLUB 1997 - 2017

OSDC 20th ANNIVERSARY WEEKLY DANCES NIGHTS (PLUS RELATED INFORMATION)

November 17 and 24, 1996

Original kickoff meetings were held at the SAC Ballroom Club (1308 Fort Crook Road, name later changed to the Bellevue Social Centre, still exists today).

January 1, 1997

The Omaha Swing Dance Club (OSDC) was officially formed and By Laws ratified. Annual dues were set at \$20 for Regular Membership and \$5 for Associate Membership (under age 18).

There were 18 members in the club at its formation ... Doug Anderson, Colleen Bull, John Clark, Judy Garretson, Gil Hill, Lu Kimpston, Janet Lenfant, Mick Merrick, Sandy Reimers, Roni Reynolds, Carol Ring, Greg Schiller, Ron Shepard, John Taulborg, Ron White, Chuck Witt, Marlene Witt, and Stan Zlochen.

The club's first dances were on Sunday evenings at Bobby Sox (near 83rd and Center, name was changed to Flashbacks in July, 1997 and still exists today).

1997

In addition to the club sponsored dances on Sundays at Bobby Sox / Flashbacks, members regularl danced at other locations to promote WCS and recruit new members. Locations mentioned in 1997 newsletters were Wednesday evenings at two locations, the New Tower Inn (near 78th and Cass Street, no longer exists) and Keno Cabana (in Bennington, still exists) and Thursday evenings at two locations, 6:00 pm at Guitars and Cadillacs (near 108th and Dodge, no longer exists) and 9:00 pm at the Shark Club (near 72nd and Center, still exists today).

March 31, 1997

OSDC was legally incorporated as a non-profit 501c organization when their lawyer, James Monahan, filed the appropriate paper with the State of Nebraska. Lawyer and filing fees were paid by a donation from club member John Taulborg.

There were 59 members in the club when incorporated.

June 17, 1997

Tuesday dances began at the American Pie / The Garage (5022 S 114th Street between L and Q Streets, originally called Shooters, name changed to American Pie on June 13, 1997 and a month later to The Garage. It no longer exists today).

The floor at Flashbacks was small so the club began looking for a larger venue. The result was this new location and night. Tuesdays became the official dance night, but dancing on Sundays at Flashbacks continued.

The club began offering free dance lessons at this new location. First dance instructors were Marty Hebert, Mary Albert, and Anne (Barone) Rice.

Costs were covered by donations with a suggested admission of \$4 for members, \$6 for nonmembers. The Garage received \$3 of this but required a \$100 minimum plus a \$30 deejay fee. The club also absorbed the dance lesson costs. Initial attendance was good but eventually dropped to where covering these costs was a challenge for the club.

August, 1997

Newsletter officially name "Footnotes" Logo contest held ... winning design submitted by Ray Hansen. The logo is still used today.

November 18, 1997

Tuesday dances were moved from The Garage to the Bel Air Banquet Room (still in existence near 120th and Center). The move was necessary because The Garage was experiencing difficulties staying open.

Costs to the club remained the same as The Garage. Initial attendance was good, but just as with the Garage, it eventually dropped and the club again had difficulties covering its costs.

February 5, 1998

Dancing began on Sundays at the Shark Club (still in existence near 72nd and Center).

Flashbacks decided to close on Sundays so the club could no longer use that as a club night out. A second official dance night was wanted and that search lead to the Shark Club.

The club now sponsored two regularly scheduled dance nights.

February, 1998

The first OSCD T-Shirts were made available ... black with red and white lettering using the club's logo.

March 5 to 26, 1998

Weekly dances at the Bel Air were moved from Tuesday to Thursday.

March 31, 1998

Weekly dances returned to Tuesday and moved from the Bel Air to Eli's Bar and Grill in Rockbrook Village (near I-80 and Center Street, its name changed to the Elite Lounge in 2008 but is now closed).

Attendance at the Bel Air had dropped, and costs were not being covered. The club was struggling to stay in existence. By chance, then club president Judy (Garretson) Merrick had a luncheon meeting at Eli's. She noticed the dance floor which led to a conversation with Dan, the owner of Eli's. He agreed to allow the club to meet there on Tuesday nights.

Dan did not require any fee or minimum and also offered to help the club by paying for the dance instruction. The club's only expense was for the deejay which they were able to cover with donations to a tip jar.

Later, Dan slightly enlarged Eli's dance floor to accommodate the club.

Because of this arrangement with Eli's, the club began to grow and become financially sound. It is likely the club would not exist today if not for the support received from Dan. This was the start of what would become a 10 year run at Eli's.

October 11, 1998

Sunday dances were moved from the Shark Club to Jumpers (inside what was then the Ramada Inn, now the Comfort Inn near 72nd and Grover).

The Shark Club decided to re-model into a sports bar so the club was asked to leave. Fortunately Jumpers was available and willing to let the club move those dances to their venue. Like Eli's, they helped pay for the dance lessons. This began more than a four year run. This move allowed the club to continue two regularly scheduled weekly dances.

October 7, 1999 to November 18, 1999

Thursday dances were added at Rio's (3809 N 90th Street, later became the Arena, now Tanners).

Tuesday at Eli's and Sunday at Jumpers dances continued as before so the club now had three regularly scheduled dance nights.

Unfortunately Rio's decided to schedule a different activity on Thursday and asked the club to leave so this arrangement lasted only two months.

January 6, 2000 to January 27, 2000

Thursday dances were again added, but this time at Grandmother's Lounge as a "trial run" (inside what was the Holiday Inn at 72nd and Grover, currently the Hotel R L).

Tuesday at Eli's and Sunday at Jumpers dances continued as before so the club again had three regularly scheduled dance nights.

Grandmother's decided this "trial run" was not working so this arrangement lasted only one month.

March, 2000

The club began a \$2 cover charge to pay for deejay and instructor cost at the weekly dances.

Although admission had been charged for special events and dances, the club had relied on donations for its weekly dances. This is the first time a set amount was requested.

2000 and 2001 (throughout the year)

Besides the weekly dances, the club had several monthly dances on Friday and Saturday at Just Dance Studio, Studio D (14715 Industrial Road), and in the home of Joan and Maury Udes.

Members would often dance other locations at non-club sponsored dance nights. Newsletters from 2000 and 2001 listed several venues where club members would go to dance ... the 18th Amendment (96th and L), Ameristar, Bluffs Run, and Harvey's Casinos (all in Council Bluffs off I-29 near I-80), McKenna's Blues and Barbeque (7425 Pacific, no long exists), Music Box (7777 Cass, no longer exists), Anthony's Restaurant and Lounge (7220 F Street, still exists), Guitar's and Cadillacs (10865 West Dodge Road, no longer exists).

August 2, 2001

After a year and a half break, Thursday dances were again added, but this time at Bushwackers (still in existence in Ralston). These dances would continue until June, 2002.

Tuesday at Eli's and Sunday at Jumpers dances continued as before so the club again had three regularly scheduled dance nights for the next 8 months.

February 24, 2002

After more than a four year run, Sunday dances at Jumpers ended because attendance had dropped to where the club was not covering its costs.

Tuesday at Eli's and Thursday at Bushwackers dances continued so the club still had two regularly scheduled dance nights.

June 27, 2002

After an 11 month run, Thursday dances at Bushwackers ended.

For the next two months, Tuesday at Eli's was the only regularly scheduled weekly dance.

August 29, 2002

After a two month break, Thursday dances were once again added, this time at the American Legion Post #1 (near 78th and Dodge).

Tuesday dances at Eli's continued so the club had two regularly scheduled weekly dances.

December 28, 2006

After more than four years, weekly Thursday dances at the American Legion Post #1 ended.

Initial attendance was good but had dropped to where the club was not covering its costs.

However, the club continued to use the American Legion Post #1 for other dances including monthly intermediate lessons during some years.

Tuesday was now the only regularly scheduled dance night and has remained that to this date.

January 8, 2008 (Tuesday)

Party for Dan (owner of Eli's Bar and Grill). Dan had just sold Eli's and the club wanted to recognize him for hosting the club for nearly 10 years.

February 5, 2008

Cover charge for Tuesday dances was increased from \$2 to \$3 to help pay increased deejay and instructor costs. This is the first increase since a set cover charge began in 2000.

July 1, 2008

Tuesday dances moved from Eli's / Elite Lounge to Arthur's 4 Seasons (near 114th and Dodge).

After Eli's was sold, the new owners closed it for several weeks for remodeling. During that time Dave and Mary, the owners of Arthur's allowed the club to temporarily move its dances to Arthur's. The club returned to Eli's on April 8 when it reopened as the Elite Lounge.

After a couple of months at the Elite, the club decided to move back to Arthur's. This ended the club's longest stay at any single location...over 10 years at Eli's during which it experienced significant growth.

June 28, 2011

Intermediate lessons were started on the last Tuesday of each month. Cover increase to \$5 on these nights if you took the intermediate lesson. Cover remained \$3 if you did only the dance.

Beginner lessons continued on all the other Tuesdays. Cover remained \$3 with the lesson free on these Tuesdays.

June 12, 2012

Tuesday dances moved to the VFW Post 2508 (near 90th and Military).

Arthur's unexpectedly closed so the club had to begin searching for a new location. At that time the VFW Club did not have an adequate sound system and was charging \$50 per night so the move to that location was considered temporary.

August 21, 2012

Tuesday dances moved from its temporary location at the VFW Club to the Passion (a newly opened club near 108th and Q, formerly the Roxbury Club, currently called Rhythmz).

Like Arthur's, The Passion did not charge a fee but the club paid the deejay and dance instructor as they had at other locations.

December 17, 2013

Tuesday dances moved back to the VFW Club.

Like Arthur's, The Passion unexpectedly closed so the club had to again search for a location.

As before, this move was initially considered temporary, but the VFW had updated their sound system and was willing to negotiate the facility fee in order to keep our dances at their facility.

As a result the VFW became the home of the Tuesday dances and currently remains that way.

April 5, 2016

Towards the end of 2015 and beginning of 2016, the club was contacted several times by ASCAP and other music licensing organizations. According to copyright laws, clubs like us are required to pay fees for the right to play music at dances. After considerable research, the club decided to pay these fees through a licensing organization called Fastdance.

Because of this considerable added expense, cover charge for Tuesday dances had to be increased to \$4. This was only the second increase for weekly dances. Admission was first set at \$2 in 2000 and increased to \$3 in 2008.

March 21, 2017

Annual dues for club membership are currently \$20 and have been that amount since first formed in 1997.

At its annual meeting, the membership voted to give the executive board permission to increase the yearly dues from \$20 to \$24. The purpose was to make it easier to pro-rate the dues per month if the board decides to change the date when dues are to be paid. As of this writing, the executive board has not made any changes so the dues are still \$20.

OSDC 20th ANNIVERSARY ELECTED OFFICERS AND OTHER EXECUTIVE BOARD MEMBERS

The club thanks all past and current officers for their willingness to serve. Without their efforts the club would not exist today ... there would be no place in Omaha to regularly dance WCS.

If you have not been an officer, please consider doing so to keep the club going for another 20 years.

NOTES ...

- 1. Executive boards served six month terms until 2004 when terms of office became one year (except for a few years in which the length varied by a month or two). Elections usually took place the month before the officers took office.
- 2. The President, Vice President, Treasurer, and Secretary are elected positions. Other positions such as Newsletter and Membership are appointed by the elected members of the executive board.
- 3. If not listed, the Newsletter and Membership positions were covered by the elected officers (usually the President).
- 4. Nick Mulder was the first regular deejay for the club. He was at Flashbacks when the club started in January 1997. He continued to be the deejay as the club moved to other locations (The Garage, Bel Air, and Eli's). Howard Borden was added as a deejay in October 1999 when the club began a second dance night at Rio's. Nick Mulder eventually left, but Howard has continued to this day. Although Nick and Howard were the primary deejays hired by the club, the officers and other members would fill in when needed (often on a volunteer basis, especially in the early years of the club).
