"A Prescription for Recovery" by Javet W-Palm Beach Gardens, FL

Al-Anon is an extra strength, long-lasting relief medication for depression, anxiety, and misery associated with the family disease of Alcoholism.

Important: When taken as directed, Al-Anon is known to substantially reduce the negative side effects associated with alcoholism and its physical, mental, and spiritual maladies.

Use Al-Anon as Prescribed:

- 1) Trust God
- 2) Clean "House"
- 3) Help Others

Al-Anon should be taken with plenty of open-mindedness and willingness.



Caution: Recommend using Al-Anon if you are capable of being honest and completely willing to give yourself to this simple program. Al-Anon is available for use by those who have a desire to recover from this family disease of Alcoholism. Al-Anon will impair your ability to maintain your misery. Do Not Take Al-Anon alone. Independent studies have shown that Al-Anon is most effective when working with others.

Common Side Effects Associated with Al-Anon: Honesty, hope, faith, courage, integrity, willingness, humility, brotherly love, justice, perseverance, spirituality and service. A spiritual awakening and a psychic change have been reported in many cases.

To reduce chronic relapse: Life style change is recommended. Practical experience shows that intensive work with another Al-Anon member insures a strong recovery with long-term spiritual effects. Consult your sponsor immediately when changes do occur. Al-Anon is recommended for long-term daily use. As with all medication, results may vary: sometimes quickly, sometimes slowly.

Warning: Do not skip doses or discontinue use, as severe re-occurrence of initial symptoms may occur. If you are experiencing a resurgence of your spirit lasting more than a few hours, you need not seek medical attention as you may be experiencing the initial effects of Al-Anon. For more information and to learn more about Alcoholism and the Al-Anon 12 Step program of recovery - we suggest you contact your local Al-Anon community directly, retain a sponsor, and read the book "How Al-Anon Works".

On May 14, the World Service Office (WSO) wrote a letter on behalf of the Finance Committee addressing the impact that COVID-19 has had at the WSO. Here are a few key points:

- Literature sales were down 75% (as of April)
- Donations were down 34% (as of April)
- Significant cost cutting measures were put into effect including elimination of Staff

As a result of this global pandemic and the financial effect it has had on the World Service Office, they are asking for member's help in accordance with the Seventh Tradition. Below are some questions to consider:
