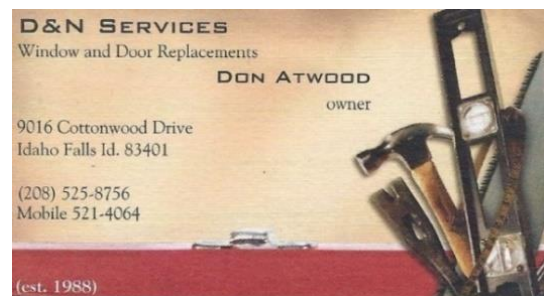
There are many brand-new officers this year. Please support your Aerie and Auxiliary officers to help them have a successful year.
