MURDER POOL TOURNAMENT

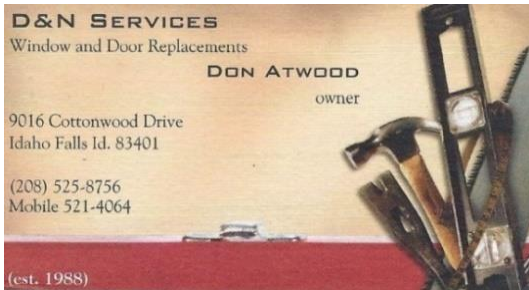
