Sports Physicals:

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K-8th grade students playing a sport must have a sport physical (within 395 days) or current health exam on file before their first practice. All forms are due by September 1st and must be on the required Illinois forms.

Health & Eye exams must be completed within one year prior to the first day of school.

Dental Exams must be dated after November 15, 2022.


