

RESOLUTION NO. 2022 - 0017
Resolution increasing per-acre Tax Rate

A RESOLUTION relating to increasing the Tax Rate on District Acreage within the "Hopkins Drainage District #2 in Thurston County".

WHEREAS, HOPKINS DRAINAGE DITCH DISTRICT #2 in THURSTON COUNTY was established in 1904 pursuant to RCW 85.06; and

WHEREAS, HOPKINS DRAINAGE DITCH DISTRICT #2 in THURSTON COUNTY has been in operation as a Special Taxing District from its creation in 1904 to this day; and

WHEREAS, the Current Tax Rate of \$ 5 per Assessable Acre has been in effect since it was set in the early 1980s; and

WHEREAS, the cost of everything including Fuel, Equipment Rental, Worker Wages, Election Costs have increased dramatically, especially in the recent years ; and

WHEREAS, in order for The HOPKINS DRAINAGE DITCH DISTRICT #2 in THURSTON COUNTY to continue to operate and pursue the issues before us, the Revenues must increase;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF HOPKINS DRAINAGE DITCH DISTRICT #2 in THURSTON COUNTY as follows:


Section 1. The Tax Rate set on the "Per Acre Assessed Land within the District" for Tax Year 2023 Collections will be set at \$ 20 per acre going forward;

Section 2. Severability. If any portion of this resolution as now adopted or hereafter amended, or its application to any person or circumstances is held invalid or unconstitutional, the validity of this resolution as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional and its application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected.




Hopkins Drainage Ditch District #2 in Thurston County
