Osage Orange Sharpshooters, 2025 As Issued Wooden Rifle—Scott Ives Memorial Match Program May 24, 2025

Sponsor: Osage Orange Sharpshooters, an affiliate of the Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP)

Day and Time: All dates are Saturdays. 8:45am registration followed immediately by match.

Location: Springfield Benchrest Rifle Club, 646 Kastendieck Rd Billings, Missouri 65610

Competition open to: All. CMP "Eligibility Affidavit and Liability Agreement" required. Notary available.

Entries and Range Operation: Fee: \$10 Registration on day of match only. Current Osage Orange Sharpshooters members no charge. Competitors will help set up and clean up range.

Multiple Registration: Competitors may fire multiple matches if space permits either as a re-entry (same type of CMP Games Rifle), or in a separate match.

Relays and Firing Points: 8 firing points, 2-3 relays depending on turnout. 24 shooters maximum. Relay not firing will score and replace targets for firing relay.

New Shooters: Coaching, loaner rifles, ammunition and equipment available by pre-arrangement. Contact match director.

Rules: Current *CMP Games Rule Book* will govern this match.

Rifles and Ammunition. As-issued military rifles legal for any CMP games and adopted by militaries before 1950 may be used: M1 Garand, M1 Carbine, 1903 or 03A3 Springfield, M1917, Vintage Military bolt rifles. Competitors supply own ammunition. .30-06 ammunition available for purchase by those who need it to shoot a match.

Available Match Courses: Shooters may elect to shoot CMP Course A (30 shots), or Course B (50 shots) course of fire.

Course of Fire: CMP GSM Courses A and B fired concurrently (30 or 50 shots), target SR-1, 100 yds.

Stage 1: 5 sighting shots in 5 minutes

Stage 2: 10 (20 Course B) shots for record, prone, slow fire, 10 (20 Course B) minutes

Stage 3: 10 shots for record, prone from standing, 80 seconds, mandatory reload

Stage 4: (Course B) 10 shots for record, sitting from standing, 70 seconds, mandatory reload

Stage 5: 10 shots for record, standing, slow fire, 10 minutes

Electronic Targets: Where possible, Shotmarker targets will be used. Owners are encouraged to bring them. Competitors are encouraged to bring a smart phone, tablet, or computer with a web browser for use with the Shotmarkers.

Awards: CMP Achievement Medals based on CMP rule book for each rifle category.
