An Equine Dentist examines, diagnose, and treat diseases, injuries, and malformations of teeth and gums. They may treat diseases of nerve, pulp, and other dental tissues affecting oral hygiene and retention of teeth.

Job Functions

Core¹ tasks include but may not be limited to:

- Examine teeth, gums, and related tissues using dental instruments, x-rays, or other diagnostic equipment to evaluate dental health, diagnose diseases or abnormalities, and plan appropriate treatments
- Administer anesthetics to limit the amount of pain experienced by equine's during procedures
- Use dental air turbines, hand instruments, dental appliances, or surgical implements
- · Formulate plan of treatment for equine's teeth and mouth tissue
- Diagnose and treat diseases, injuries, or malformations of teeth, gums, or related oral structures and provide preventive or corrective services
- Prescriptions for antibiotics or other medications
- Advise or instruct equine owners and handlers regarding preventive dental care, the causes and treatment of dental problems, or oral health care services
- Fill pulp chamber and canal with endodontic materials
- Treat exposure of pulp by pulp capping, removal of pulp from pulp chamber, or root canal, using dental instruments
- Remove diseased tissue, using surgical instruments
- Analyze or evaluate dental needs to determine changes or trends in patterns of dental disease
- Perform oral or periodontal surgery on the jaw or mouth
- Plan, organize, or maintain dental health programs
