Programs are subject to Article 7 - Equine Liability Immunity, Chapter 9 - Livestock Generally of Title 47 - Animals, Livestock and Poultry of the South Carolina Code of Laws, 1976.

Description

SM offers instruction in the correct ways to care for horses. Topics include equine anatomy, nutritional needs and types of hay and grains, veterinarian and farrier care, basic management techniques, grooming and bathing techniques, braiding, clipping, tack and equipment, and stall beddings. Each lesson is 45 minutes.

Note: Mounted horsemanship skills are not taught.

Fees

All program fees are subsidized based on the value of the services provided rather than the actual cost to provide the services. Differential pricing is available, on occasion and at the Center's discretion, for all half and full sessions at discounts ranging from 10% to 30% of the value of the services when paid in full. Additional discounts are available for up to six people in a group and enrollment in multiple programs.
