Equine Veterinarian provide vaccinations, treat injuries, diagnose and treat diseases, and perform on equines.

Job Functions

Core¹ tasks include but may not be limited to:

- Examine equines to detect and determine the nature of diseases or injuries
- Treat sick or injured equines by prescribing medication, setting bones, dressing wounds, or performing surgery
- Collect body tissue, feces, blood, urine, or other body fluids for examination and analysis
- Inoculate animals against various diseases, such as rabies or distemper
- Counsel clients about the deaths of their equines or about euthanasia decisions
- Operate diagnostic equipment, such as radiographic or ultrasound equipment, and interpret the resulting images
- Advise equine owners and handlers regarding sanitary measures, feeding, general care, medical conditions, or treatment options
- Educate the public about diseases that can be spread from animals to humans
- Establish or conduct quarantine or testing procedures that prevent the spread of diseases to other animals or to humans and that comply with applicable government regulations
- Euthanize equines, only if necessary
- Research diseases to which equines could be susceptible
- Conduct postmortem studies and analyses to determine the causes of deaths
