

THERAPEUTIC RIDING (TR)

Programs are subject to Article 7 - Equine Liability Immunity, [Chapter 9 - Livestock Generally](#), of Title 47 - Animals, Livestock and Poultry of the South Carolina Code of Laws, 1976.

Description

TR is designed for participants with disabilities and special needs to learn unmounted equestrian skills such as grooming techniques, tacking and untacking procedures, and mounted equestrian skills in the English discipline with the assistance of a Horse Leader, a Side Walker, and a Silent Off-Side Walker, or a combination thereof, if needed. Participants will achieve skills that increase motivation, pride, independence, garners new outlooks toward skill development, a greater sense of problem solving, and a healthier sense of sportsmanship. Each lesson is 45 minutes.

Fees

All program fees are subsidized based on the value of the services provided rather than the actual cost to provide the services. Differential pricing is available, on occasion and at the Center's discretion, for all half and full sessions at discounts ranging from 10% to 30% of the value of the services when paid in full. Additional discounts are available for up to six people in a group and enrollment in multiple programs.
