All boarding options provide the benefits of horse ownership without the day-to-day responsibilities of horse ownership as owner's are not required to visit their horse on any type of schedule or at all. Instead, our Stable Management Staff will muck stalls, feed, and bring your horse in and out of pasture as described based on your board of choice. In addition, all boarding options include either grass hay pastures, legume hays, or a combination of both as well as unrestricted use of amenities on Sundays. Restricted use of amenities is enforced Monday through Saturday based on the programming schedule.

A snowflake (\*) denotes the feeding of hay from October through March unless cooler temperatures require an earlier start and/or a later finish in supplemental forage.

Sunshine (©) denotes full baths from May through September unless warmer temperatures dictate an earlier start and/or a later close of the wash stall.

A closed lock (a) denotes a required and refundable \$25 security deposit for 60 minutes of care as a Comfort Companion in the event of incidentals.

A thumb tack ( \$ ) denotes the administration of spot-on fly control only when grain feeding is not selected.
