- · Submit timely documentation of rendered services and maintain adherence to Medicaid guidelines and administrative codes.
- · Attend staff and supervisory meetings, in-service trainings, and staff development activities.

- · Provide transportation services as assigned.
- · Contribute to the growth and maintenance of the group census by actively engaging in marketing efforts and promoting the program.
