
Presentation of Five Books


Below I will present them briefly for those who could be interested in similar topics and works.

The year started with the first book: *Infinitism*: *How to make Infinity your philosophy for life*.

In this book, the philosophical theory of Infinitism is

presented for the first time and under the form semi-fiction of а journey. Four people gather regularly to discuss the question of worldview and its necessity for having a better and meaningful life.



Even though the subject is philosophical and complex, but the narrative is pleasing and simple. It's a friendly dialog among people who try to simplify the intricate topics and make sense of everything in their life. The interesting point is that they can finally meet their goal and fabricate a worldview for themselves. This worldview is the philosophical theory of *Infinitism* where it's stated that "Everything is infinite or is not". From this assertion will emanate many others that join together coherently to present a vision of existence based on infinity.

If everything is infinite, so is the capacity of matter to provide us all we need and desire, and also our aptitude to get there. The endless resources, on the one hand, and the infinite capacity of you and me to reach these resources, on the other hand. This is how *Infinitism* suggests a worldview that could be immediately operational for anyone who wants to see infinity, not as a purely conceptual point, but the real factuality of matter.

All these points are developed in this book, and you can go through the construction of this worldview step by step and see how the four personalities of this philosophical story are endeavoring to get there.



A bit later, in this year of 2021, I published a second book entitled: *Infinitylogy:* Foundations of a New Discipline.

What is this about?

Infinitism presents its statements based on some arguments, but the latter need to be checked and verified through facts and data. This is the mission that a new discipline takes in



charge. *Infinitylogy* wants to go through the material world and looks for the factuality of the concept of infinity.

This task is very subtle since we know that infinity cannot have any end or border to be treated as such, but it could be observed and studied in its ongoing and endless action. So, Infinitylogy translates infinity in terms of <u>infinitude in</u> <u>action</u> and tries to track it in the fabric of reality.

In this book, we explain what could be the substrates of such a discipline. It explains what could be the main directive outlines of *Infinitylogy* and where one can find some specificity for its methodology.


The book is a first attempt to formulate the framework of this discipline and the principles that will be the fundamentals for such. The first ideas and definitions of *Infinitylogy* and some explanations about the way that they can establish its premises are presented in this book. I recommend the lecture of this volume to all those who want to get an idea on how a new discipline could have as its specific field of study the boundless concept of infinity.

Also in 2021, we came back with a third book: **Basis of Infinitylogy**: How and why study Infinity.

In this book, I went further than that in presenting more details on *Infinitylogy* and its particular topics. I also developed several lines that provide a methodology for acting on infinitude within matter.



The book challenges some basic rules and laws that had been admitted in science and became a kind of conceptual enclosure for a free thinker who wants to see in the matter an infinite structure and subsequently endless resources to be explored.

For instance, why we should think that there are some *'Elementary particles'* or 'Fundamental elements' while we know that there is always something smaller that composes any particle or subparticle that we identify within a phenomenon.

The atomic structure is endless as *Infinitylogy* pretends. In this book, we present some ideas on the infinite composition of matter and show how through such a vision we open new horizons for intervention on the matter.

We also suggest some techniques that are inspired jointly from the science and technology like the isotopic approach and from the *Infinitism* that suggests there is no end in the composition of any material occurrence. The book gives several examples of what we could discover and apply if we go over the fabric of matter with the idea of an infinite composition.



The book explains how *Infinitism* can act as a worldview to change our relationships with the material environment and how we could effectively start treating the world otherwise in order to put an end to this man-made prison that we fabricated by concepts like scarceness and ending.


