FEAST OF TRUMPETS Opening Service



(CANDLE LIGHTING)

[Blessed is YAHWEH Eloheinu,, KING of the Universe, Who sanctified us with His commandments, and to Whom we sanctify this time by the lighting of the candles.]

(Reader #1)

Sound the great shofar for our freedom, raise the banner to gather the exiles and to call us together from the four corners of the earth. Blessed is YAHWEH, WHO brings HIS scattered people home to serve HIM. (Sound The Shofar)

(Reader #2)

Blessed is YAHWEH Eloheinu, KING of the Universe, WHO has given us life and health to behold the return of this festive season. Since we are called by HIS NAME and sanctified by HIS commandments, let us walk in the light of HIS countenance.

(Reader #3)

Happy are they that know the sound of the shofar. He who has ears, let him hear and let him hope in the NAME of YAHWEH. Let him remember his first love. Let him repent of his ways and return home once again.

(Sound The Shofar)

[Hear oh Israel, YAHWEH is Mighty One, YAHWEH is ONE! Blessed is HIS NAME, and HIS glorious Kingdom forever and ever.] [Shema yisra-ayl YAHWEH eloheinu YAHWEH ECHAD. Baruch

SHEM k'vod mal'chuso L'olam va-ed.]

[You shall love YAHWEH Eloheicha with all your heart, with all your. soul, and with all your might. And these words which I command you today shall be upon your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your children, and you shall speak of them when you sit in your house and when you walk on the road, when you lie down and when your rise. You shall bind them as a sign upon your hand, and they shall be as reminders between your eyes. And you shall write them upon the doorposts of your house and upon your gates.]

(Reader #4)

We praise You, YAHWEH, Eloheinu and Elohim of our Fathers,

Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, the Great, Mighty, and awesome FATHER, WHO

bestows grace and creates all, and remembers the kindness of our

fathers bringing a Redeemer to their children's children for HIS

NAME sake. YOU WHO bestowed a son upon Abraham in his old age then asked our father to return him to YOU again, and Abraham did not

fail to offer up to YOU his one and only son in living faith. And so YAHWEH, YOU spared Isaac, his son, in YOUR mercy, providing a lamb in his place. On this feast day we remember YOUR redemption in the sound of the ram's horn -- recalling the ram caught by its horns and offered for Isaac.



Read Genesis 22 (Sound The Shofar)

On the Mountain of Sinai, Oh YAHWEH, You sounded the first trumpet, announcing the sacredness of that place, calling YOUR people to assemble before YOU, and heralding the descent of YOUR Messenger to the summit to deliver the blessed Torah. As YOU sounded the shofar on that day to reveal YOUR instructions to us,



so this day we also sound the shofar in obedience to those instructions.

(Reader #7)

Read Exodus 19 (Sound The Shofar)

(Reader #8)

YAHWEH, our FATHER, ever giving good gifts to YOUR children, You have bestowed on us the wondrous gift of the shofar to provide direction, offer warning, and to call us to YOUR assembly. As an eternal order YOU commanded the sound of the trumpet to be heard over every celebration, on every feast and every Sabbath and New Moon, but especially on this night. For in the sound of the shofar we hear the call to remember YOU and to come together to praise YOUR NAME. [HALLELUYAH]

(Reader #9)

Read Numbers 10:1-10 (Sound The Shofar)

(Reader #10)

In the days when no kings reigned and everyone did as they pleased; scorning YOUR Torah and serving other gods; YOU, oh YAHWEH, sent Gideon with the torch, the pitcher, and the horn to deliver YOUR people from bondage to the barbarous idolators and from the worship of their gods. To show that YOU alone are Elohim and no other; You did not give YOUR servant superior wisdom, numbers, or strength, but only the sound of the shofar and the power of

YOUR NAME. And so YOU saved YOUR nation.

(Reader #11)

Read Judges 7:1-22 (Sound The Shofar)


(Reader #12)

Seven days, oh YAHWEH, You sent YOUR people circling the walls

of Jericho with YOUR holy priests leading the way; horns in hand

and silent as the grave, but on that seventh day seven times YOU

sent them around that city and commanded them to sound the shofar to show forth YOUR mighty power. The walls fell before the blast and



YOUR people plundered the wicked and did give great glory to Your NAME.

(Reader #13)

Read Joshua 6:1-25 (Sound The Shofar)

(Reader #14)

YAHWEH, when YOUR people cried out for a king against YOU, YOU gave them the desire of their hearts, and YOU raised up Saul to be their king. Yet he would not keep YOUR Way, oh YAHWEH. He forsook YOUR Torah, and YOU forsook him in turn, taking another in his stead. YOU raised up David, YOUR servant, a man after YOUR own heart, to hold the throne of Israel .. From the sheepfolds of Bethlehem YOU called him out and chose him from among all his brothers to bear witness to YOUR NAME in all the earth. With oil from the horn, YOU anointed him king and set him high above his enemies to serve YOU in Truth.

(Reader #15)

Read 1 Sammuel 16: 1-13 (Sound The Shofar)

(Reader #16)

And from the lineage of this king has come to us the King Messiah Yahshua, born in the sheepfolds of Bethlehem, chosen:above all others, blessed and sanctified, and anointed from on High to be Ruler of YOUR people, oh YAHWEH.

KIDDISH

(Reader #16) continued

On the night in which He was betrayed, Yahshua took bread, gave thanks, and broke it saying, "This is My body which is broken for you. Do this in memory of Me."

[Blessed is YAHWEH, Eloheinu, King of the Universe, WHO brings forth bread from the earth.]

[Baruch atah YAHWEH Eloheinu, MELECH ha-olam hamotsea

l 'kim min ha-aretz.]

(Reader #17)

After supper, He took the cup saying, "This is the cup of



the Renewed Covenant in My blood in My Blood, poured out for you and for many for the forgiveness of sins. Do this in memory of Me."

[Blessed is YAHWEH, Eloheinu, King of the Universe, WHO creates the fruit of the vine.]

[Baruch atah YAHWEH Eloheinu, melech ha-olam borei prei ha-gafen.]

Yahshua, our Messiah, gave His life for our own. He died, was buried, and three days later came back to life at YAHWEH 's command. He ascended to Heaven and sits in honor at YAHWEH 's Right Hand, where He awaits the appointed time to return to rule the earth. His appearing will be announced with the trumpet call from above, so all the earth below will hear and know and be ashamed of their sins. Let us therefore at this time sound the shofar to show we believe this; to say that it will be so, and to signal all the earth to repent before it is too late. (Sound The Shofar)

(Reader #18)

Truly the sound of the shofar is sweet to our ears, for it is the call of our King. It is the medley of victory and the music of triumph. Let the sound of the horn be a sign to all the living of the promise the Messiah made to us long ago -- That He will return exactly as He said, like a thief in the night on a day and time we do not expect; and of that momentous occasion, no one knows the day or the hour. May the long blast be a warning to all the world to be ready to turn from its wicked ways unto the commands

of YAHWEH, and to repent for HIS Kingdom is near! (Sound The Shofar) [HALLELUYAH]

(Reader #19)

Indeed the sound is sweet, and this day is sweet and only what is sweet is eaten at this time. Therefore, dipping the apple in honey, we celebrate the sweetness of the prophecies of the past and the sweetness of the future promise And we enjoy the sweetness of the bounty of the earth and the sweetness of the blessings of Heaven

[Blessed is YAHWEH, Eloheinu, KING of the Universe, WHO creates the fruit of the tree]

*Repeat similar blessings for bread dipped in honey, for the



pomegranate, and fruit of the season. (Sound The Shofar) [HALLELUYAH] (Read Genesis 21)

Day Service

You, oh YAHWEH, keep my lamp burning; My Elohim turns my darkness into light.

[Blessed is YAHWEH, Eloheinu, King of the Universe, Who made the moon to light our way.]



(Reader #1)

Blessed be its Maker, and blessed be the day it is reborn. [Blessed is He Who formed it for us and reformed it again today.]

(Reader #2)

Blessed is He Who set it in place
[For signs, for seasons, for days, and for years.]
[HALLELUYAH!]

(Reader #3)

Sound the trumpet in the New Moon, in the time appointed, on your solemn feast day. For this is a statute for Israel, a law of the Elohim of Jacob.

[Happy are all who hear the sound of the shofar. He who has ears, let him hear.]

(Sound The Shofar)
[Recite the Sh'ma]

(Reader #4)

Read Genesis 1:14-19.

(Reader #5)

Blessed is YAHWEH, Eloheinu, King of the Universe, Who formed all the Heavens by His Holy WORD, all their hosts by the WORD of Power. He fixed them in place and gave them His Torah, so they should never change nor ever alter their course. With rejoicing and gladness, they do His will; He Whose way is just and true. HE commands the moon to be renewed, a crown of glory for all the Holy. And He orders moreover that we renew ourselves in rightness and to honor our Maker as the moon does the sun.

(Reader #6)

Read Col. 2:16-17.

(Reader #7)

Blessed is YAHWEH, Eloheinu, King of the Universe, Who sanctified us with His commandments and commanded that we celebrate the New Moon. He requires that we be renewed like the moon; in our thoughts, in our words, and in our actions -- that we should ponder the passing month, put all sin behind us, and prepare for the trials and triumphs of the coming lunar cycle with patience and with praise.

(Reader #8)

For all that is past -- good and bad [Praise YAHWEH for renewal.]

(Reader #9)

For all yet to come -- life and death [Praise YAHWEH for renewal.]

(Reader #10)

And for Messiah our Master, Who restores our souls [Praise YAHWEH for renewal.]



(Reader #11)

Blessed is YAHWEH Eloheinu, King of the Universe, Whose Kingdom shall be established without resistance and Whose reign shall endure without end. For this Kingdom we pray and prepare, the Kingdom which will be & now is ... both within our thoughts and intentions, and

within our desires and deeds. May all our habits hold steady to this truth and all our actions follow after this pattern -- of one New Moon to another and from one Sabbath to the next. Blessed is YAHWEH, Who gave us now the pattern of HIS future Kingdom, the plan of Heaven to be put to work on Earth.

(Reader #12)

Read Lam. 5:21.

(Reader #13)

Blessed is YAHWEH Eloheinu, King of the Universe, Who renews the moon as a sign of new beginnings, and beckons us to renew our hearts to serve Him. Blessed is YAHWEH,

WHO restores our strength

in the Risen Saviour and reminds us today to reflect HIS Light to the world.



May it be YOUR will, oh YAHWEH, Eloheinu, and Elohim of our fathers, that You would renew us this month for excellence and blessings, for joy and gladness, for redemption, and reconciliation, for support and sustenance, for pardon and peace. May You grant us life and health, goodness and grace, forgiveness of sins, fear of Heaven, and compassion for the lost ones and for the broken. May we be without shame before YOU this month and without sorrow beneath the moon. Let our lives be marked by love of YOUR Torah, love of YOUR Son, love of YOUR people, love of YOUR creation, and love of YOUR self. Bless us, we pray through the Name of YOUR "Son", Yahshua, King Messiah.

Read Psalm 148:1-3, 5-6, 13. (Read Genesis 22)

Glosing Service

(Reader #1)

Blessed is YAHWEH, Eloheinu, KING of the Universe, WHO has sanctified us with HIS commandments and commanded us to hear the

sound of the shofar. And how sweet a sound it is; the memorial of HIS ancient mighty acts and a rehearsal of all still yet to come.

YAHWEH, our Heavenly Father, YOU gave us YOUR Son and Saviour

(Sound The Shofar) [HALLELUYAH]

(Reader #2)

to live holy as one of us and to horribly die for all of us. And because YOU are truly faithful, YOU did not let YOUR Holy One see decay, but raised Him up to new and unending life in YOUR NAME, and through His sacrifice YOU give new and endless life to all who believe in His Name. At the Appointed Time, YOU took Yahshua, our Messiah back to YOURSELF to sit at YOUR Right Hand in glory and honor, adoring YOU without end. And thus we wait for His return as He and YOU both promised when YOU make His enemies His footstool. raise Him high as King in Jerusalem, and set all the world under His authority.



Read Psalm 2, 10; Acts 1:6-11

(Reader #4)

Of that great and glorious day we long for and let it be known by the blast of the trumpet that for the King's own this day is favored triumphant; but for all others - the lawless and the loathsome, this day forebodes terror; for truly YAHWEH comes to settle accounts with His Creation, to judge the earth in perfect



righteousness, and to rule all things with a rod of iron. As we know neither the day nor the hour when these things shall take place, let the sound of the horn call all people to waking, all penitents to weeping, and all passive saints to be watchful of their ways.

(Reader #5)

Read Zeph. 1:16-18; Zech. 9:14-17; Matt. 24:15-51; Mark 13; Luke 21:8-33 (Sound The Shofar)

(Reader #6)

For now we wait and we watch and we work and we warn of the Judgment to come sooner now than ever before. As we bear witness in our own age to the beginning of the end; we prepare our hearts in hope of the Final Appearing of our Saviour, the King Messiah, Yahshua. In our time, we behold the prophet's words bearing fruit and being fulfilled before our eyes. Indeed, Israel has been restored once more and the exiles are returning to the Holy Land. The way is being made for rebuilding the Temple of YAHWEH in Jerusalem. The enemies of His people are increasing upon the earth. Ever and anon they are inventing new means of making evil. And more now then ever before, the blessed message of Yahshua is being believed and received among the Jewish people.

(Reader #7)

Read Tim. 3 (Sound the Shofar)

(Reader #8)

With the mighty arrival of Messiah, once more we look for the rising to take place -- the resurrection of the dead at His righteous appearing. All the holy ones of the ages will be restored to life rule the earth under Yahshua's authority. But first must come the ultimate evil before the epitome of all that is good.

Before our Master comes back to us, the man of sin must first appear, the anti-messiah -- the man of lawlessness, who will defile the Temple, displace all gods, and declare himself to be worshiped as the only deity and that in YAHWEH's Holy House. Let the sound of the shofar set all sacred hearts to guard against the coming of the Lawless one and choose this day to follow instead the Messiah Himself, the Man of Righteousness, the Man of the Torah, the Lawful One in worship of the One and only Elohim, YAHWEH Sabaoth.

(Reader #9)

Read 1 Cor. 15:35-53; 1 Thess. 5:1-6; 2 Thess. 2:1-12 (Sound The Shofar)



(Reader #10)

Seven trumpets shall resound around the world announcing each

a Judgment of YAHWEH over the nations that defy HIM and HIS Annointed. Seven trumpet blasts to signal the perfect end and the flawless wrath of the Lamb and HIS FATHER; YAHWEH Sabaoth, the CREATOR comes to destroy. So let us number the judgments to come, counting them without fear but in faith, knowing they fall not on us who love HIM and HIS Annointed, but upon every king and nation who does not call on HIS NAME and will not keep HIS Way.

(Reader #11)

Read Rev. 8:1-13; 9:1-21; 11:15-19 (Sound The Shofar after each trumpet count)

(Reader #12)

And then the end shall come, not only of evil's reign, but of his life; for the Lamb shall return to His pasture and the Good Shepherd to His flock -- the High Priest shall come to cleanse the Temple and the King shall arrive to rule in Zion. Let Heaven and the Earth flee before Him and let all humankind pledge fealty for He Who died and lives forever more shall be installed in Zion as Sovereign of the planet. Place your trust in Him this day while time lasts and while He is away and awaiting your faith. Grace is given only now, but no mercy will be found in His hand that day He bears the sword. "Bless the Son, lest He be angry and you perish in your way."

(Reader #13)

Read Rev. 19:1-21 (Sound The Shofar) [HALLELUYAH]
