And to all who follow this Wisdom and establish this as their Rule, who limit their labors for the love of these hours, these shall flourish and know freedom like no other. They shall have bounty in famine, bliss in misery, and the best of all blessings at all times.



First Reader: The Children of Israel shall observe the Sabbath, to make it an eternal covenant throughout there generations. Between YHWH and the children of Israel, it is a sign for all time that in six days YHWH made the Heavens and the Earth, and on the Seventh Day, He ceased from work and rested.

Leader: Come, my beloved, to meet the Bride. Let us welcome the Sabbath. All: ( Echo )

Leader: Come, let us welcome the Sabbath, for it is the source of all blessing. From the beginning and aforetime it was chosen and cherished...

All: Last in Creation yet First in Intention.

Leader: Come in peace, oh Crown of her Husband. With songs of joy and gladness, we welcome you for His glory. Dwell with us in happiness and hope among faithful, holy people, and on the morrow go your way to meet our King Messiah. Come, oh Bride, come.

Leader: Magnified and Sanctified be Your Great NAME, oh YAH, in the worlds which You created according to Your will.


All: Let Your Great NAME, oh YHWH, Eloheinu, be praised forever and to all eternity.

Leader: He is our King! All: There is no other!


Leader: And you shall know, this day, and take to heart, that YHWH is Elohim alone in the Heavens above and on the Earth below, there is no other!

On the night in which He was betrayed, Yahshua took bread, gave thanks, and broke it, then said, "This is My body which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me."



At that time Yahshua went on the Sabbath Day through the grain; and His disciples were hungry, and began to pluck the grain, and to eat. But when the Pharisees saw it, they said unto him, "Look, Your disciples do what is not lawful to do upon the Sabbath Day. But He said unto them, "Have you not read what David did, when he was hungry, and they that were with him; How he entered into the House of Elohim, and did eat the Shewbread, which was not lawful for him to eat, neither for them which were with him, but only for the priests? Or have you not read in the Torah, how that, on the Sabbath Days, the priests in the Temple profane the Sabbath, and are blameless? But I say unto you, 'That the Greater Temple is here'. But if ye had known what this means, 'I will have mercy, and not sacrifice', you would not have condemned the guiltless. For the Son of Man is Master even of the Sabbath Day."



May YHWH reign over us now, and soon over all the earth for eternity, to banish corruption from our hearts and idolatry from under heaven. Let us be glad this day then, and rejoice in His Salvation (Yeshua). And let us love all the more as we see the day approaching.

Assembly: We will do unto others as we would have them do unto us.
