

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING
A CROSSWALK CONTROLLED AREA
ALONG OAK STREET WITHIN THE TOWN OF ORESTES**

WHEREAS, the Town of Orestes does now desire to establish a certain area of Oak Street to be a crosswalk controlled area, wherein pedestrian traffic shall enter the street for purposes of crossing from one side to the other only by way of a designated crosswalk.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED By the Town Council of Orestes, as follows:

Section I - There is hereby declared to be a crosswalk controlled area along Oak Street commencing at a point 528 feet west of Oak Street's intersection with Prospect Street and running east and west therefrom a distance of 100 feet. In this designated area, all pedestrian traffic desiring to cross the street from either north or south shall do so only within a certain designated crosswalk. The crosswalk shall be 19 feet wide and 61 feet long, and shall run diagonally across Oak Street, and shall be marked so as to distinctly indicate the same is intended for use as a pedestrian crossing.

Section II - Any person operating a motor vehicle shall stop and yield the right-of-way to any pedestrian entering the crosswalk until such person has safely and completely crossed.

Section III - Any persons violating provisions of this Ordinance may be fined in a sum not to exceed One Hundred and no/100 Dollars (\$100.00).

Section IV - This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage by the Council and publication as by law provided.


