Section IV - Enforcement.

- A. A child who commits a curfew violation under this chapter is subject to the enforcement procedures of Indiana Code 34-28-5-1. Whenever a complaint is filed against a child for a violation of this ordinance, the town shall direct a copy of the complaint to the Juvenile Division of the Madison Circuit Court, Division II, and to the child's parent, guardian or custodian, if such person is known or can be identified by reasonable inquiry.
- B. In addition to the imposition of fines as set out hereinafter, the Court, upon request shall order such injunctive relief as is appropriate and necessary to prevent a child from committing further violations of this ordinance.

Section V - Curfew; Responsibility of parent, guardian or custodian.

It is unlawful for a parent, guardian or custodian of a child under the age of eighteen (18) years knowingly to allow that child to commit a curfew violation under this ordinance.

<u>Section VI</u> – A violation of this ordinance may be punished by the assessment of a fine not to exceed Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).

<u>Section VII</u> — Upon passage of an appropriate ordinance, the Town Council may amend the curfew hours as set out hereinabove for such temporary periods of time as may be deemed appropriate and/or necessary by the Town Council and as set out specifically within said amending ordinance.

Section VIII – Should any provision (Section, paragraph, sentence, clause or any other portion) of this ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid for any reason, the remaining provisions or provision shall not be affected, if and only if such remaining provisions ca, without the invalid provision or provisions, be given the effect attended by the Council in adopting the ordinance. To this end the provisions of this ordinance are severable.

<u>Section IX</u> – This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage by the Council and publication as by law required.
