# AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING THE HOURS FOR THE WEST OAK STREET PARK AND PROVIDING A FINE FOR VIOLATIONS

WHEREAS, the Town of Orestes, Indiana owns and operates a certain recreational area within the town commonly known as the West Oak Street Park (hereafter, "the Park") and the Town Council of Orestes finds that in order to provide for the reasonable maintenance and operation of the Park, and in order to maintain the safety and health of the community, it desires to set the hours for the Park to be from sunrise to sunset; and to further prohibit the operation of motor vehicles within the Park.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: The usual and customary hours for use by the public for the Park shall henceforth from sunrise to sunset. Individuals desiring to be in the Park at times other than as prescribed herein may petition the Town Council for such permission.

SECTION TWO: The operation of motor vehicles, including automobiles, motor bikes, motor cycles, scooters, mopeds, or other similar motorized vehicles, within the Park shall be prohibited.

SECTION THREE: Any person violating of the provisions of this ordinance may be fined not more than \$100 per violation.

SECTION FOUR: This ordinance shall be effective upon passage by the Council, signature of the Clerk Treasurer, and publication as by law required.
