AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1466, AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR NO PARKING ZONES WITHIN THE TOWN OF ORESTES

No person shall stop, stand, or park a vehicle, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic, the law, a traffic control device, or the directions of a police officer in the following place: on both sides of Superior Street, north from its intersection with Oak Street.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Town Council of the town of Orestes, and publication as by law provided.
