

Type 02

Side loader trailer

A specialized trailer equipped with hydraulic cranes or lifts on the sides, designed to load and unload heavy, bulky, or oversized items like containers, machinery, and construction equipment efficiently.

Type **03**

Full truckload (FTL)

Transportation of a large quantity of goods in one truck, typically for a single customer.

Type 04

Less-than-truckload (LTL)

Transportation of smaller shipments from multiple customers in a single truck.

Type **0.5**

Heavy haulage

Moving oversized or overweight items, such as construction equipment or machinery.

Type 06

Refrigerated haulage

Transporting perishable goods like food and pharmaceuticals at a controlled temperature.

Type

Flatbed haulage

Carrying goods on an open trailer without sides or roof, often for large or awkward items.

Type 08

Dry van haulage

Transporting non-perishable items in a standard enclosed trailer.

Specialised haulage


Moving specific goods like hazardous materials or livestock, requiring specialized equipment and handling.
