

PROPOSED ORDINANCE

ALLOWING ANIMALS TO DEFECATE ON PUBLIC PROPERTY OR ON PRIVATE
PROPERTY OF OTHER PERSONS.

It shall be unlawful for any owner or person in control of any animal to fail to immediately remove the fecal matter deposited by their animal on public property or on the property of another without the consent of the owner or the person having control of the premises. A violation of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine not to exceed \$100.00. This Ordinance shall not apply to a person with a disability who is accompanied by a service dog.
