PROGRAMS OVERVIEW

Our programs and community engagement activities are designed to meet the youth we serve and their families where they are. We are intentional about embedding ourselves in the community through partnerships with schools, municipal governments, nonprofits and other community-based organizations, thereby ensuring that the programs and resources we provide are accessible to kids and families right within the communities they call home. During 2024, we proudly launched our latest youth development endeavor: the Afterschool Child Enrichment (ACE) program.

AFTERSCHOOL CHILD ENRICHMENT (ACE) PROGRAM



In partnership with the City of Lauderdale Lakes and with support from the USTA Foundation, our **Afterschool Child Enrichment (ACE) Program** provides a dynamic blend of tennis instruction and academic support for under-resourced students ages 6-14 in Broward County, FL.

This free weekly program creates a fun, inclusive, and safe space where children build tennis skills, strengthen academic readiness, and grow in confidence. ACE participants not only learn the fundamentals of tennis, but also develop important life skills, improve physical fitness, and gain valuable academic support through tutoring, literacy activities, and homework help.

Each weekly session includes time dedicated to academic enrichment, ensuring students complete homework and receive tutoring or study support, followed by physical activity and on-court tennis instruction.

Now in its inaugural year (August 2024 – June 2025), the ACE Program currently serves 34 students and continues to reflect our commitment to holistic youth development—both on and off the court.



SCHOOL ENGAGEMENT TENNIS (SET) INITIATIVE

Our **School Engagement Tennis** (**SET**) **Initiative** brings the joy of tennis directly to Title 1 schools across Broward County—at no cost to students or their families.



Through fun, inclusive, and safe clinics, students learn the fundamentals of tennis, often for the very first time. Each session includes dynamic games and skill-building drills designed to strengthen hand-eye coordination, footwork, and balance. To support continued play and participation, students receive special giveaways, such as a drawstring bag, tennis ball, mini hand sanitizer, sports water bottle, and—when available—a free tennis racket.

During the 2023–2024 school year, we visited four Title 1 schools to host seven clinic, including both Broward County Public Schools campuses that serve students with significant behavioral health needs. These visits reflect our deep commitment to inclusion and our belief that all children, regardless of ability, deserve access to enriching physical activities and supportive mentorship.











STUDENT TENNIS ACHIEVEMENT RECOGNITION (STAR) PROGRAM

Our **STAR Program** offers a free, six-week tennis experience designed for under-resourced youth ages 3 to 14 in Broward County, FL. In a fun, inclusive, and supportive environment, participants build a strong foundation in tennis fundamentals while developing athletic skills and learning tools for mental resilience.

As the program progresses, students are introduced to increasingly advanced tennis techniques and enjoy opportunities for friendly competition with their STAR peers. They also learn simple, engaging games they can play at home or on local courts—encouraging continued play and a lasting connection to the sport.



Healthy Bodies, Healthy Minds

Each clinic includes a mental resilience session led by a licensed clinical social worker and mental health therapist. These sessions teach evidence-based strategies for emotional regulation, including breathing and mindfulness exercises, healthy outlets for stress through physical activity, and the importance of overall wellness. Students also explore how making healthy choices—like staying active, eating well, and avoiding harmful substances such as tobacco, vapes, and illicit drugs—can support both their physical and emotional well-being.

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GLOBAL GOOD INITIATIVE



Our Global Good Initiative reflects our unwavering commitment to extending the benefits of tennis to youth beyond U.S. borders. Through this initiative, we collect gently-used and new tennis gear—including shoes, clothing, rackets, balls, and nets—from our generous community of tennis lovers and supporters. These donated items are then distributed to under-resourced young athletes in West Africa and the Caribbean, helping remove barriers to participation and encouraging their continued growth in the sport.







This isn't just about reusing equipment—it's about creating opportunities. By placing these items into the hands of kids eager to learn and play, we're supporting their development on and off the court and helping fuel their dreams.

In 2024, we proudly shipped and distributed barrels of shoes and clothing to youth in Kingston, Jamaica, and delivered four barrels and three boxes of gear—including racquets, bags, and apparel—to young players in Tema, Ghana. These efforts are just the beginning of our vision to make tennis a truly global game of opportunity and empowerment.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT INITIATIVE

Through our **Community Engagement Initiative**, we demonstrate our commitment to making the world around us a better place, on and off the court. Where opportunities to enrich youth, families, and our community present themselves, Dennis Tennis Serving Love will be there in the thick of it!


