

COVID 19 REOPENING PROCEDURES

Scheduling – Lessons will be scheduled, so that there is a gap between students to reduce the number of persons in the studio at any one time.

Waiting Room – The waiting room will be eliminated, and students /parents will remain in their cars until they are notified that the teacher is ready to begin the lesson.

Limit on Items – Students are asked to limit the items they bring with them into the studio (only essentials: music book & music instruction materials, cell phone, etc.)

Hand Sanitizer - Hand sanitizer stations will be at the entrance of the studio and inside instruction rooms, with specific instructions to use it prior to entering the studio and upon leaving the studio.

Temperature – Temperature checks will be performed on any person entering the music studio using Touchless forehead scanners. If an elevated temperature is noted, the students will be instructed not to enter the music studio and to proceed home.

Masks - State orders require the use of facemasks by both the student and studio employees.

Sanitation - A set schedule to sanitize all areas where persons have been during the time the music studio was opened has been established. This includes: instruments, tables, chair arms, door knobs, light switches, hangers or anywhere else where people come in contact. Surfaces will be sanitized using products that meet the EPA's criteria to use against COVID-19.

Instruction – Private instruction will adhere to all CDC recommendations regarding physical distancing ⋄ spacing.

** Students are advised not to come to the music studio if they have or have had in the past 14 days a cough, a fever, shortness of breath, difficulties breathing, flu-like symptoms, gastrointestinal upset, or experienced a loss of taste or smell. **

*All procedures are based on the CDC recommendations and The Music Teachers National Association (MTNA)
