FREE 30 HOURS FOR WORKING PARENTS

All working parents please note that if your child's 3rd birthday falls within **1st April 2021 – 31st August 2022** then you can apply for the 30 Hours Code on www.childcarechoices.gov.uk. If you are eligible and received your 30 – hour – code, then please submit the code to the nursery office latest by **20th August 2022** to enable us to validate the code ready for use in the Autumn Term 2022. All parent who are accessing 30 hours this term must remember to renew their codes every 3 months so that your code does not expire.

Haringey Healthy Start

Are you Pregnant or do you have Children under 4? You could be eligible for Healthy Start vouchers worth £3.10 (pregnant women and children 1- 4) - £6.20 per week for children under 1. If you are at least 10 weeks pregnant, have a child under four years old and if your family get benefits then you can get these vouchers; can be used for cows' milk, infant formula (stage one only), fruit and veg and pulses. Get an application leaflet from Haringey.gov.uk or contact health visitor or midwife.

Late Collection Fee

Please note that a late fee of £10 will be applied for every 5 minutes you are late to pick your child after 6pm. However, if you are late during the day the hourly rate (£8.50) applies. Always ring to inform us of such details/any changes at least 15mins before nursery closes. Always remember we are only a phone call away.

COVID-19 HOME TESTING

With regard to the government guidelines, we ensure that all staff are doing Covid tests twice a week to stop the spread of Coronavirus in the nursery. We request that all **parents must carry on wearing face** coverings and that you keep a 2m distance from other parents whilst on site.

Keynotes to our Parents

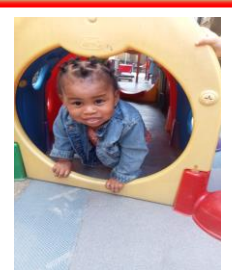
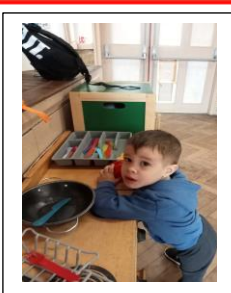
