1909 - 1943

Mitsuo Nakawatase emigrated from Kagoshima, Japan in 1929 at the age of 20. His older brother George had been in the United States since 1924.

Mitsuo went to Topaz alone while George and his family went to Tule Lake. Mitsuo died on July 7, 1943.
