1886 - 1944

Keijiro Kimura emigrated from Hiroshima, Japan in 1905. His wife, Sei, arrived in 1908. They had three children: Kiyoshi, Kimiye, and Setsuko.

Oldest daughter, Kimiye, married in 1933. Her husband, Frank, was taken by the FBI and sent to Lordsburg. Kimiye went into Topaz with the rest of the Kimura family and her two children, Willie and Edward.

Son, Kiyoshi, married his wife, Shizuko, in Topaz. The couple transferred to Tule Lake in 1943.

Keiji passed away on August 3, 1944. He was survived by his wife, three children and two grandchildren.
