

PFC Robert Sachio Hoshino

1914 - 1944

Robert Hoshino was born in 1914 in Alameda, CA. He was the youngest of four boys. His father, Seizaemon, died in 1938.

Robert enlisted in April 1941, but was honorably discharged (most likely after the bombing of Pearl Harbor). He and the rest of his family were sent to Topaz.

Robert was called back to active duty and sent overseas in July 1943. He was killed in action on August 26, 1944 in Italy.

Memorial services for Pfc. Robert Sachiyo Hoshino who was killed in action on the Italian front on August 26 will be held here next Tuesday night in the Protestant Church.

Pfc. Hoshino, 30, is survived by his brother, Keith, who resides at 5-1-E.

He was honorably discharged from the army just before the evacuation and was recalled to active duty last October and was stationed at Fort Sheridan, Illinois, before he was sent overseas last spring.
