

Mitsuru Nakai

1888 - 1943

Mitsuru Nakai emigrated from Ehime, Japan in 1908. He settled in Seattle, WA. In 1918, he married Michie Kikuchi.

The Nakai's first son, Michikazu, was born in Seattle in 1920. By 1930, the family had moved to CA and a second son was born, Hirokazu.

Mitsuru died suddenly on April 30, 1943. He was survived by his wife and two sons.
