NOTES:

- Tag the Line is restricted to FULL and HALF Tags, but calling Tag the Line directionally for Girls or Boys to stop in a central wave (to create a $3 / 4 \mathrm{Tag}$ ) is an acceptable use case.
- It is recommended that callers use the SSD teaching order as provided by CALLERLAB ${ }^{\text {m }}$ with omissions as noted above. If necessary for attendance at standard SSD dances, teach the omitted calls at the very end of the SSD teaching order.
- It is recommended that callers continue to teach the remainder of the Short Plus program while de-emphasizing the omitted SSD calls listed above.
- It is recommended that callers talk with club presidents to get clubs on board preparing dancers for the Short Plus program. Ask the clubs to support these efforts by hosting Short Plus dances. This will allow dancers to become familiar with the calls and club members to befriend the new students. Assure clubs that the remainder of the Plus program can be taught at a later date if they wish.
- Single Circle and Anything is defined as facing dancers Circle Up 2 Halfway, drop hands and then execute the 'Anything' call.
