Are you looking forward to seeing the butterflies in the spring



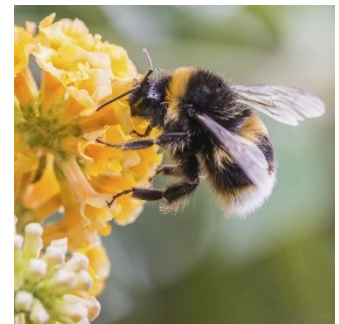
