Another rare event was the "Carlsbad Flower Fields." They advertise it is "one of the most spectacular and coordinated displays of natural color and beauty anywhere in the world." We agree. Dianna and I spent nearly 3 hours there (on our scooters of course) and handed out dozens of tracts. We also enjoyed the wonders of God's creation in the flower world. What a wonderful creator we have.
