To this day it still exists, except now the true joy comes not only in dwelling on the gospel but boldly telling the world. I continue to thank our great God and Savior Jesus for the work done in behalf of sinners at Calvary, and also ask that He would grant the time and strength to proclaim Him. PTL.
