This month was like no other month ever. One morning at 2:30 a.m. or so, Dianna quite terrified said we must go to emergency. Her heart was pounding, chest pains, difficult to breath and every bad thing you could think of happening from her heart. We rushed to emergency and they began the tests. She was connected to a heart monitor and unbelievably a bright red warning light would come on and the pulse literally showed "0". This was happening every couple of minutes and often would stop for 6 or 7 seconds making her light headed. Unbelievably, for a brief time her brain and organs were deprived of oxygen. This was terrifying to say the least.

They immediately scheduled for a pacemaker but couldn't perform the surgery for about 24 hours. Since time was critical they decided to put a temporary pace maker in at her bedside with minimal anesthesia. The process turned out to be extremely difficult and took nearly an hour an a half as she watched them struggle.

The following day she received the permanent pace maker along with new medications. Her racing heart is calmed considerably and after a couple of months of healing she may require a cardioversion or an ablasion as further treatment. We are grateful that God has granted us his mercy and healing is taking place. We are also grateful of modern God ordained marvels in medicine. Dianna is now stable and progressing beautifully.

Please pray for her continued progress and that we may use this experience before the world as evidence of God's goodness in all things. Other than a couple of weeks of terror we were still able to have numerous outreaches. PTL.
