Definitely a strange month. We started strong early in January but came to a halt before mid month. Dianna had her right knee replaced on Friday January 12th and just a week later I had surgery on my left knee, which was replaced 14 years ago, for orthoscopic surgery. With much help from many Christian friends we worked through the many difficulties. Long story short Dianna is 3 weeks into the new knee and doing fairly well. Still a lot of pain but she can move around on a walker and is making progress daily. Another couple of weeks and she should be able to progress to a cane. Will probably take a few months to walk without a cane.

My surgery wasn't nearly so invasive and I have recovered to use of a cane and should be driving soon. Although I haven't been able to get out yet I should be back on the streets by time you receive this newsletter. Please pray for our continued healing.

One Sunday morning we were watching a "Zoom" service of our Church. As the pastor preached our doorbell rang. I could see 2 JW men with briefcases. Witnesses have avoided us for many years. The leader introduced himself as Tom. He said he had spoken with me more than 20 years ago here in my home. He had recalled with great passion I had witnessed to him even going into my office and bringing out out a JW bible to point something out.

His purpose in coming by was he simply wanted to know if I still lived here. Also, he recalled we both had raced motocross. With that we spoke briefly about our motocross careers. He willingly gave me his phone number and the latest Watchtower brochure. Since he was with someone and their spouces were waiting outside they left cordially.

Although with great anticipation when I contacted him by phone he didn't want to talk further on religious issues. I decided to send him a single question anyway by text concerning the resurrection and identity of Jesus.

It breaks my heart that he doesn't want to talk further. I told him I would pray for him and please contact me again.

God knows the details. I was so excited and so broken hearted, yet God must be at work. I pray this will be the year God rescues a JW who will be a bold witness for Christ. Perhaps like Peter Barnes was to many of you and me as well.
