

Synopsis: Divorcee Carrie is struggling to keep her family bakery business afloat when her ex husband Bryan appears on the scene under the guise of looking out for his 40% interest in the business. When a customer accidentally drives her car through the front of the bakery the insurance won't cover the repairs and the bank won't loan her money she is reduced to accepting money from him in return upping his share of the business to 50%.

When what was supposed to be a short term loan from her ex turns into him sticking around for the foreseeable future, Carrie and Bryan fall into old married habits that threaten Carrie's future with her new boyfriend, an actor on the brink of "making it," a result in which Bryan delights.

When an elderly friend has a heart attack and Bryan instantly jumps into action, Carrie sees him for the grownup he's become and her new boyfriend diminishes in comparison. Things go from bad to worse when he shows up unannounced and finds Carrie and Bryan together in a compromising situation.

Thrown into an emotional tailspin, Carrie must make a decision about the direction in which she wants her life to go. Carrie realizes that what she wants and what she needs aren't always the same thing. But getting there is half the fun.
