We are conveniently located at a typical Guanajuatense barrio, but sometimes narrowed labyrinthine alleys here may be confusing to move back or forward, so

it's never a shame to ask for help in case of you have got lost; or simply, call us!

BASIC INFORMATION & REGISTRATION

In case you didn't contact us by email before, you can receive at our Administrative Office all the information you need about prices, study system & type of classes, accommodation, and other services we offer. Registration, this is a form that contains basic student's information. This info will help us to learn more about each one of our student's requests; to keep in contact with relatives if would be necessary; or to send more information or study materials during or after your staying with us.

WITTEN & ORAL EXAM

In order to place each student at their correct study level, we will provide you with 2 different exams:

Written grammar exam, this is not a test to approve or disapprove anyone based on what they know about language, it's merely a reference for us to determinate where is your best place in our study program and if we Could accommodate you in the classes we already have opened, or if we should open new classes for your assigned level. Oral exam, consists in a complementary short interview that helps us to determinate if your knowledge on grammar corresponds equally or unequally with your skills to express yourself on Spanish; so don't get nervous about having to speak a little bit on Spanish within your 1st hour with us!

SCHEDULING CLASSES IS TO UNDER-STAND YOU BETTER

Classes at *Helita* start every day at 9 and finish at 1:30 with a lunch break from 11 to 11:30. During this time classes are: 9 a.m. 1st Practical Grammar {language theory 1} 10 a.m. Practical Spanish {studying materials focused on developing writing & oral comprehension skills} 11 a.m. Lunch break {SCHOLAR MEXICAN RECREO} 11:30 a.m. 2nd Practical Grammar {language theory 2} 12:30 p.m. Conversation

Around this schedule, we can arrange an ideal just for you depending on your learning interests (less grammar, more practice); your time available if you have any kind of job here, you only have specific time a day to study; or sometimes even living with a Mexican family may affect your time to have classes.
