Beautification

Budget

Dori gave an overview of the budget, only 6 homeowners have yet paid their annual dues. She also discussed the need for a quickbook type accounting software, either free or paid, to help organize the treasurer duties. Dori also announced she had secured a venue to hold a trial monthly meeting at Perkins restaurant on Trolley road in April.

Vice-President

Bob mentioned it was time to replace the old Bulletin Board at front entrance as the current one is in dis-repair and may soon fall over due to rotted wood. A photo sample of a new Billboard was shown to everyone to discuss. The price is estimated between \$790-\$890. Anyone wishing to voice their opinion for or against a new announcement board and vote, should come to the April meeting. He also mentioned that it was necessary to strictly enforce the Convenants

concerning Yard debris on sidewalks, unkept yards, abandoned vehicles and street lights obstructed with a property owner's trees not being trimmed. An elderly man tripped and hurt himself recently on broken sidewalks, and the president has notified the county to request repairs for some sections of the sidewalks in our subdivision.
