- · Political Leaning


The Legislator Rank is simply the result of sorting the Rank coefficient from + to -.

The Political Leaning is basically define with the more neutral, i.e. Moderate in the middle separating the Conservative from the Liberal.

Coefficient:

This column has the basic calculated coefficient as well as the political party (in color)

- The Coefficient is calculated by adding all of the bill ratings and dividing by the number of votes cast.
