its common facilities and campground at Bogg Springs Baptist Camp, 784 Hwy 84, Wickes, Arkansas 71973 from			
June 9th	until	June 13th	Bogg Springs Baptist Camp has agreed to allow the rental
group to use the facilities provided that the following terms and conditions are met:			

1. <u>Cost:</u> The cost shall be \$135 per person. This includes all youth campers and all adults that stay and eat at the camp for the agreed upon timeframe. An additional fee of \$30 per night per unit will be incurred by the group or the individual that chooses to use our motel units, RV spots or the pink house. Any other costs that arise will be discussed and resolved between the camp manager and the rental group's leadership.

## 2. Policies and Guidelines

- 2.1. Each group leader is responsible for informing participants in their group of all camp polices & guidelines.
- 2.2. Smoking is not permitted on camp property.
- 2.3. Alcoholic beverages, firearms or gambling are not permitted.
- 2.4. Medication should be registered and administered by the camp nurse.
- 2.5. Modest dress should be always practiced and is at the discretion of the staff.
- 2.6. Each camper is expected to participate in the camp programs and attend religious services, if applicable.
- 2.7. Each group is expected to leave the campgrounds and buildings clean before leaving.
- 2.8. Any building defacing activities are forbidden.
- Specialized activities (swimming, challenge courses, etc.) are only permitted when facilitated by trained camp staff.
- 2.10. No personal pets are permitted during camps or retreats unless being housed and contained in a reserved RV site. A variance to this policy may be given by the camp manager at his discretion if requested prior to arrival.
- 2.11. Signs, posters, decorations, etc. must not be affixed to any painted surface or interior walls without prior approval of the camp manager.
- 2.12. Each group is responsible for the campers' care of equipment and buildings and may be held responsible for any damage done to camp property. In cases where property has been damaged or abused beyond normal wear, above named group will be billed for and agree to pay for all damages and additional cleanup.
- 2.13. Violation of camp policies, guidelines and other requirements may result in expulsion from the camp with no refund of any fees paid.

## 3. Other Requirements

- 3.1. Each camp is responsible for providing their own medical personnel (camp nurse) that are qualified to administer medication and provide first aid.
- 3.2. Any adult (18 and older) on Bogg Springs campground is required to pass a criminal conviction and sexual misconduct background check. Records of criminal convictions should be obtained by performing a criminal background check using a criminal history database for each adult volunteer's permanent residence. Records of sex offender status should be obtained by performing a check using a sex offender registration database for each adult volunteer's permanent residence, such as the ACIC Sex Offender Registry, which may be accessed at the Arkansas Department of Public Safety. If requested by the State Health Inspector, evidence or documentation of the searches must be provided within 10 days. If an individual has been convicted of a crime and/or sex offence, the camp office must be contacted to see if that adult can be made eligible for attendance.
- 3.3. Each group agrees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless Bogg Springs Baptist Camp, its trustees and employees from and against any and all claims, demands, causes of action, or liabilities incurred by Bogg Springs Baptist Camp or its employees, arising from above named group's acts or omissions of above named group's vendors, employees, contractors, or persons attending the meeting or event with the express or implied permission or invitation of above named group, except as may arise from the negligence or willful misconduct Bogg Springs Baptist Camp, its Trustees or employees. Each group will be responsible for the control and supervision of the people in attendance during the use of the facility to ensure no harm is done to persons or property.

## 4. Preservation of Religious Voice and Rights

- 4.1. This campground primarily exists to aid the churches of the American Baptist Association in carrying out the great commission by providing a venue for the teaching of the good news of Jesus Christ. Secondly, this campground exists to aid others who share the same vision and goal of spreading the good news of Jesus Christ. While not all groups desiring to use this campground are religious in nature, it is expected that any group attending hold to Christian values and seek to instill Christian values in the campers attending. It is also expected that any group attending not actively contradict, undermine, or oppose the beliefs of the American Baptist Association as found at <a href="https://www.abaptist.org/beliefs">https://www.abaptist.org/beliefs</a>.
- 4.2. By signing this Agreement, you acknowledge and agree that Bogg Springs Baptist Camp retains the right, to be exercised in their sole discretion, to refuse or expel any group or individual that engages in activities or publicly declares view that the camp finds substantially inconsistent with their religious standards.
