


Camp Location

CODE OF CONDUCT

All campers are expected to obey the Scriptural command of 1 Corinthians 10:31. Attendance & participation are required of each camper in all activities of this camp. All clothing must be acceptable in the realm of Christian decency. Tight fitting or revealing clothing, tank tops, or clothing advertising rock groups/music, tobacco, alcohol, etc. is not permissible upon arrival at camp or during the encampment. Mini dresses and short skirts are not to be worn. Dresses and shorts are to be mid thigh in length or longer (preferably longer). All girls and women, school age and up, must wear dresses or long pants to the evening service. Dresses with halter-tops or spaghetti straps must have a covering. All boys and men, school age and up, must wear long pants to the evening service. The Rules Committee will determine approval of questionable clothing. Smoking and the use of any other tobacco product are prohibited on the campgrounds. Mixed swimming shall not be permitted. Swimming suits shall be worn only at the pool. Those wearing swim suits to and from the pool must wear a robe or be fully clothed.

WHAT TO BRING

Worship and Class: Bible, pencil, note pad
Bed clothes: pillow, sheets, and blanket
Personal articles: soap, towels, brush or comb, toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, sufficient clothing for worship and play
Money: The camp fee includes meals from Monday evening to Friday morning. Hamburgers can be purchased for Monday's lunch. Spending money will be required for additional snacks, soft drinks, or souvenirs available at the concession stand.

What NOT to Bring: Cell phones will be limited to adult sponsors and pastors. Please leave cell phones at home. Skates and skateboards are not permitted at camp. Laser lights are not allowed. Drones are not permitted.
