General Meeting

Commander Robbie Robinson: Called for the start of the February 1st, 2024, General meeting at 1900 with the appropriate opening ceremonies.

Chaplin Steven Sheets: Offered opening Prayer.

- Commander Robbie Robinson Introduced Area B commander Jo Garrett, NEC Sal Brandon Curry, 4th district Chaplin Homer Wine, Mayor Gregory, DAV Commander Bob Casher and Auxiliary Jane Casher.
- Mayor Gregory of Elizabethtown spoke about the growth of Elizabethtown. Blue oval is expected to have over 5,000 jobs openings by 2027. Pant one which is called Kentucky one will be operational by the second quarter of 2025. Kentucky two has been delayed but they still say they will reach their goal by 2027. The two plants in Glendale have caused us to grow as well. We will also be opening two new plants. That makes the items needed to make the batteries. Which are being built as we speak. They plan to open when the first battery plant opens. This will bring 200 to 250 jobs to E-Town. Spoke about things needed to be done for the Growth of KY. We have 156 recovery residents in the City of E-Town. Two things Kentucky is known for is our Sports bar and our Vietnam Wall. We are really proud of the American Legion Park. We were and 4th class city but now we are known as a home rural City. We are working really hard to get a Veterans clinic in the City of E-Town.
- DAV Commander Bob Casher Spoke about PTSD. He bought the right to a movie, a true Documentary "Here is Better". About four Veterans. It documented inpatient, outpatient and at home dealing with their PTSD. On the 20th of March we will be showing this movie free of charge at the Pritchard Community Center. There will be consolers from the VA who will talk about the effects of PTSD. He showed a short video about victims of PTSD.
- **Chaplin Stephen Sheets** Talked about and showed a video of the Four Chaplains who died in WWII on February 3rd 1943. A torpedo hit the right side of the ship. The chaplains tried to give directions to try to save as many soldiers as they could. The four Chaplains took off their life

preservers and gave them to four soldiers they didn't even know. So they could possibly survive. The chaplains joined arms and began singing hymns as the ship went down.

- **Chaplin Stephen Sheets** Today there are several memorials around the United States honoring these for men.
- **NEC SAL Brandon Curry** made a motion to accept the last month's minutes. Motion was seconded all 40 members said yay 0 members said nay.
