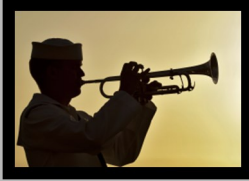

From the desk of the Commander Hardin Post 113

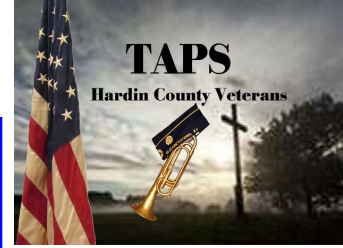
Dear Legionnaires and Family Members,

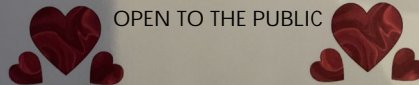

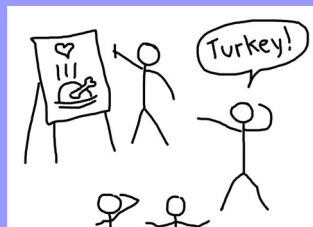
