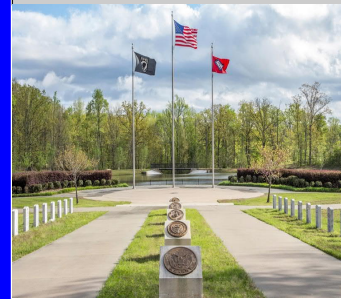

Legion Family Devotion / June Issue

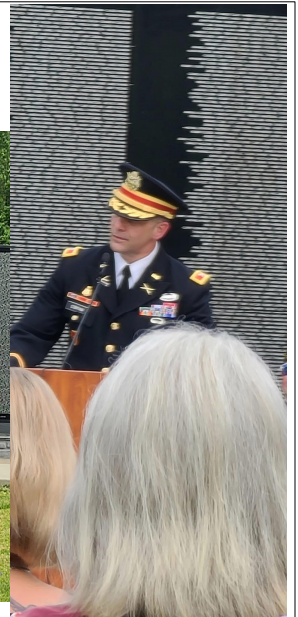
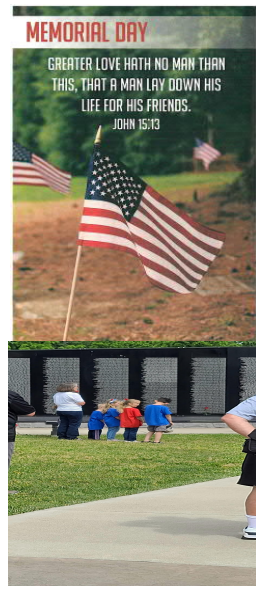
