



I wanted to tell you all how honored we are to have been part of Taylor Besler's story! Over a year ago a tow truck brough an urn in that held the ashes of Taylor, they had been found in the trunk of a car, and he didn't know what to with them.

After some looking around, we were able to find his Facebook page, and the funeral that he had been cremated in. We called the funeral home who said they would call back, which we never heard back from, we reached out to everyone in Louisville with his last name. Still no luck.

I set his ashes in the lounge, thinking if he was stuck with us, we might as well get to know him. One day I was sitting next to Lisa Napier, who asked why he was in the lounge. After telling her the story, she was on it like Sherlock Holmes. Within days she had already spoken to his employer, with in the week she had spoken to his family!

All of Taylor family now lived in Alabama, and they had no clue he was even lost. They had been told by his wife that his ashes had been spread on the beaches of Florida. But wanted their big brother home. While Lisa and I made plans to mail him home, our Sons of the American Legion Commander, Brandon Curry told us he would be passing through the area on July 15th and would take him home.
