Executive Meeting

06/25/25

The meeting was called to order at 1758 hours by the commander. Opening ceremonies were conducted.

Steve Jagger from Modern Woodsman group is looking to have a picnic on post grounds late August, early Fall. Event would have car show, games and vendors. Commander informed him that it would be discussed and would get back to him with decision.

Drew Chitty, report on FOB's, the committee recommended a deposit of \$5 per FOB. Discussion was held on whether to charge a deposit or not for the FOB's. The proposal will be presented at the general membership meeting. The issuing will begin on 12 July 25, during early bird signup and 1st Thursday of month 1800-2000hrs. They will also be distributed on the 2nd Monday and 2nd Thursday of the month between 1800 and 2000 hours. Only the 1st Vice or Adjutant can issue FOBs.
